Dear Secretary McNulty:

The Commission's Tentative Orders in the above-captioned dockets, published in the March 6, 2010 Pennsylvania Bulletin, established a 30-day public comment period, requiring that comments be submitted under both dockets on or before April 5, 2010.

By this letter and pursuant to Section 1.15 of the Commission's regulations (52 Pa. Code §1.15), the Energy Association of Pennsylvania ("Association"), for itself and its member companies, hereby moves for an additional two (2) days in which to file comments to both Tentative Orders.

In its Tentative Orders, the Commission directed interested parties, when filing comments, to consider the Proposed Rulemaking Order (Docket L-2009-2104274), and the Proposed Policy Statement (Docket No. M-2008-2065532). Given the complexity of the issues involved in these two orders, as well as the number of other pending orders requiring comment, 30 days has proven simply too short a time to develop fully responsive comments.

Therefore, the Association and its member companies request that the Commission extend the comment filing deadline by two (2) days, to April 7, 2010.
