It is interesting that there are no negative comments on this docket. But who getting so many free items or services or making or saving so much money would complain?

I received my copy from Judge Melillo, mailed 7/30/2010.

I can only infer that the PUC wanted to keep it under wraps.

It does not contain ANYTHING new in the Settlement.

The Commissioners should know that the contracts between PPL and their contractors already deal with # 1 and # 2 has been going on (by a lady named Jill) since I was working with them.

**So after all this time (since November 2007) the state's regulatory body agrees to what is *already in place*.**

Quite an investigation, almost 3 years and this is what the citizens get.

None of the costs to the citizens, who pay for WRAP were addressed. If PLL did not pay for the call backs (through WRAP funds) then the citizens paid anyway through Block grants and funding for CAP. None of free work for landlords was addressed.--- None of the costs for CFLs, insulation, Inefficient Refrigerators, water heaters ACs, beds, (that's right, beds) doors, windows, and more.

There is still a relationship between PPL and certain contractors that has not been broken for years. There is no competition. No one at the PUC ever tracked the money, or the costs for any given address.

To have so much time go by and to have NOTHING changed is not laughable but sad in the extreme, some might say even criminal. But that would be up to others to decide.

The Commission has to decide it will let this mockery of a settlement stand.

Yes, it is a complicated issue. But that is what the investigation was for. It is pathetically evident that the PUC is not capable of such a task.

The Commissioner should require the investigation to be reopened and use the resources freely offered to the PUC by the same sub-contractor, unnamed in the docket, to prosecute this case in a manner that does not embarrass the PUC. As it stands now, this Settlement if approved will hurt the PUC beyond anything imaginable in the past.


