10. PROPOSED SERVICES: Describe in detail the services which the Applicant proposes to offer. If proposing to operate as a facilities-based Competitive Local Exchange Carrier, provide a brief description of the Company's facilities.

IntelePeer will provide fully managed, hosted, on-demand peering infrastructure to directly exchange voice traffic over IP or legacy TDM networks between any application and any telephony device. Specifically, IntelePeer seeks authority to provide facilities-based and resold local exchange and interexchange telecommunications services in Pennsylvania. IntelePeer will offer basic local exchange services, custom calling features, and interexchange toll services, including toll free services, to business and enterprise customers.

While IntelePeer will not initially offer prepaid local exchange and interexchange services, IntelePeer may offer such services in the future. IntelePeer may also provide access services to payphone service providers. IntelePeer will offer basic local exchange services, custom calling features, and interexchange toll services, including toll free services, to business and enterprise customers. Facilities-based local exchange service will be provided via (1) commercial wholesale agreement with incumbents, (2) IntelePeer's own facilities, or (3) a combination thereof. Initially, toll services will be provided via IntelePeer's underlying long distance carrier. IntelePeer, however, seeks the full range of resold and facilities-based local exchange and interexchange authority so that it can have the flexibility in provisioning services in the future.

IntelePeer seeks to offer service throughout the service territories of Verizon-North, Inc., Verizon Pennsylvania, Inc., and United Telephone Company of PA d/b/a Embarq within Pennsylvania. Specific services are described in the Company's attached tariffs; as services are added or changed, the Company will make appropriate revisions to its tariffs, as required by law and Commission rules.

Grant of this application will promote the public interest by increasing telecommunications service competition in Pennsylvania. IntelePeer will provide customers with high quality, cost effective telecommunications services, with an emphasis on customer service. In addition to driving prices closer to costs, thereby ensuring just and reasonable rates, competition also promotes efficiency in the delivery of services and in development of new services. These benefits work to maximize the public interest by providing continuing incentives for carriers to reduce costs while, simultaneously, promoting the availability of potentially desirable services.

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
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- 1. Fold the first printed page in half and use as the shipping label.
