Dear Secretary McNulty:

In compliance with the Opinion and Order entered in this proceeding on September 24, 2009, and the related Secretarial Letter of February 25, 2010 granting an extension of time until March 8, 2010, Peoples Natural Company LLC (“Peoples”) files this Notice regarding the SEARCH/POR aspect of the 1307(f)-2009 Settlement. As a part of the approved Settlement, Peoples agreed to file a notice within thirty (30) days of the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission’s Order in Docket No. A-2008-2063737 (Stock Transfer Application), advising of its anticipated course of action with regard to filing a voluntary Purchase of Receivables program (“POR”) or an updated cost of service study. The afore-mentioned Secretarial Letter granted an extension of time for the submission of this Notice to March 8, 2010.


Peoples hereby notifies the Commission and the parties to the 2009 1307(f) proceeding that it is electing to submit an updated Cost of Service Study related to the POR issue as part of its annual Purchased Gas Cost 1307(f) proceeding to be filed on or

about April 1, 2011, or in its next base rate case (whichever is earlier). Peoples wishes to advise the Commission that it will give careful consideration to including a voluntary POR in its next base rate case by weighing its expected impact on furthering the development of a competitive natural gas choice market in Peoples' service territory.


