

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SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT


THIS AGREEMENT is by and between the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission's Bureau of Transportation and Safety (BTS), through Assistant Counsel Stanley Brown and Regency Transportation Group, Ltd. (Respondent), through its attorney, William A. Gray, in connection with the above-captioned complaint proceeding initiated by BTS. The parties agree as follows:

1. The complaint alleges that Respondent has airport transfer authority at A-00112970, F. 3 which it abandoned.
2. Respondent filed an answer to the complaint denying that it had abandoned its airport transfer authority.
3. Respondent subsequently filed an Application for Approval of Abandonment or Discontinuance of Service on September 24, 2010.
4. A hearing was held in Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania on September 28, 2010 before Administrative Law Judge Mark A. Hoyer. At the hearing, the parties engaged in settlement discussions to attempt to resolve the complaint and agreed to file a certificate of satisfaction pursuant to 52 Pa. Code §5.24 to satisfy the complaint.

5. In order to satisfy the complaint, Respondent has agreed to pay the Commission a civil penalty of One Hundred (\$100) Dollars, to be paid by Respondent within ten (10) days of receipt of the Certificate of Satisfaction.


6. By satisfying the complaint, Respondent and BTS have agreed that Respondent is not admitting to violating the Public Utility Code or the Commission's regulations but rather the complaint has been satisfied for the purpose of resolving this matter and to avoid the costs and expenses which would be incurred should this matter be litigated to a conclusion.

7. The parties agree that the complaint is being satisfied pursuant to a certificate of satisfaction being filed by BTS pursuant to 52 Pa. Code §5.24 to which this Settlement Agreement will be attached and that the complaint docket shall be marked closed upon the filing of the certificate of satisfaction.

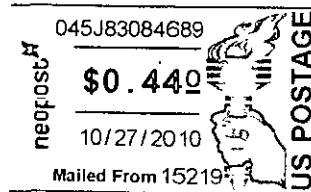
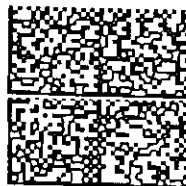
