Dear Mr. Farinas:

I am in receipt of the settlement agreement letter dated November 10, 2010. I object to number six in the settlement letter which reads, "Beginning with the December 2010 due date you will enter into a temporary payment arrangement for \$165 budget bill plus \$21 towards the arrears for 12 months. You understand that the budget is subject to revision."

I object. I would like the \$165 budget payment to be permanent. The issue is the upcoming winter months and the lack of insulation that I have in this home. I stated to Mr. Irizarry, that I have had an energy audit performed which revealed no insulation throughout my home. I have had a programmable thermostat installed also. If the \$165 budget payment is not permanent, my budget payments usually go to \$500+ (previously PGW bills were submitted to PUC documenting this) during the winter months. After filing Chapter 7 bankruptcy (documented) and my recent job loss I cannot afford for this to happen.

If the budget bill of \$165 cannot be made permanent, then I request PGW provide weatherization assistance so that I may reduce my gas usage and reduce my heating bills during the winter months. At this time, I cannot afford to have my home fully insulated.

**Therefore, the hearing scheduled for Tuesday, November 23, 2010 is necessary.**

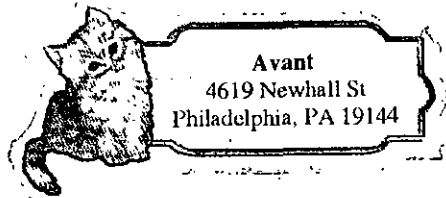

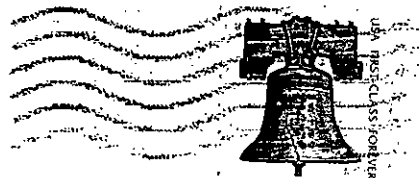
