Plaintiffs filed litigation against John Tobelmann (person identified in this Application) individually in his capacity as bookkeeper/borrowed servant of NuEnergy Group and Paul Hydok, owner of NuEnergy. Plaintiffs alleged non-payment of earned commissions. On July 28, 2008, US District Court Judge Sheridan granted the defendants' Motions for Summary Judgment, including the Motion of John Tobelmann, and dismissed all of Plaintiffs' claims against him. (A copy of Judge Sheridan's order is attached). Plaintiffs appealed Judge Sheridan's dismissal order to the Third Circuit where the matter was placed before Mediator Penny Conly Ellison for resolution. Through Mediator Conly Ellison, the parties achieved full and final settlement of the claims, and the matter was dismissed with prejudice on September 4, 2009 (a copy of the dismissal order is also attached). Per its terms, the Settlement Agreement is confidential.

7. FINANCIAL FITNESS

- Applicant shall report to the Commission the percentages of total electricity supplied by each fuel source on an annual basis:
- Applicant will be required to meet periodic reporting requirements as may be issued by the Commission to fulfill the Commission's duty under Chapter 28 pertaining to reliability and to inform the Governor and Legislature of the progress of the transition to a fully competitive electric market.

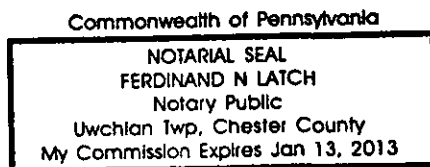

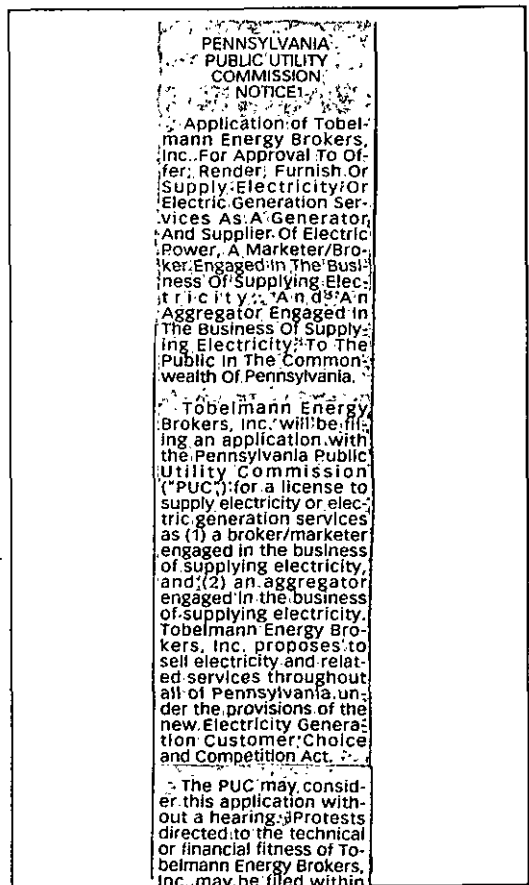

This Agreement is made on June 09, 2010 (the "Effective Date"), between Tobelmann Energy Brokers, Inc (Broker) with offices at 5401 Lister Court, Chester Springs, PA 19425 and Washington Gas Energy Services, Inc. (WGES) with offices at 13865 Sunrise Valley Drive, Suite 200, Herndon, Virginia 20171.

Whereas WGES is a retail seller of electricity, renewable energy credits and natural gas and operates in Maryland, the District of Columbia, Virginia, Delaware, and Pennsylvania.

Whereas, Broker is engaged in soliciting electricity, renewable energy credits and/or natural gas sales bids by retail sellers of same to businesses who are or may become customers of WGES or other retail sellers.

Whereas, Broker is authorized and qualified to do business in the jurisdictions in which WGES is operating, and represents that it has obtained, and will maintain, all necessary authorizations, permits and brokerage licenses, as may be required by a state or county agency or by the public service commission, in such jurisdictions.

Whereas WGES wishes to participate in providing bids to Broker for the purpose of competing to obtain contracts for retail electricity, renewable energy credits and/or natural gas sales to customers in jurisdictions in which WGES is licensed.

Therefore, in consideration of the mutual promises and agreements hereinafter set forth the Parties agree as follows:

1. **BROKER'S OBLIGATIONS.** WGES and Broker agree that Broker, in its sole discretion, may solicit price quotes from WGES to sell WGES products and services to customers and prospective customers of WGES. In connection with such solicitations, Broker agrees as follows:

(a) Broker agrees that for all price quotes it solicits from WGES hereunder, Broker shall not make any representation to existing or prospective customers that Broker is an agent of WGES. Broker shall only be authorized to represent that Broker is acting in its capacity as a broker presenting customers with price quotes from WGES, and that customers can decide whether or not to enter into sales contracts with WGES based on such price quotes.

(b) Broker shall have no authority under this Agreement to alter any of the terms and conditions of WGES standard sales contracts with customers, or to provide any interpretation of any provision in such contracts that is inconsistent with the terms and conditions therein. Broker shall have no authority to negotiate any provision in any contract between WGES and a customer. Broker shall indemnify WGES from any loss under any contract executed hereunder that is obtained in violation of this Paragraph 1 (b).

(c) If a customer accepts a price quote provided by WGES to Broker hereunder, Broker agrees to use reasonable efforts to assist WGES to obtain final execution of the contract between the customer and WGES.

(d) Broker shall be responsible for ensuring that the customer's contract signatory is authorized to execute the contract on behalf of the customer. Broker shall obtain and provide WGES with documentation of such authority.

2. **NON-EXCLUSIVE AGREEMENT.** This Agreement is of a non-exclusive nature, and each Party retains the unconditional right to market their respective products and services to customers in their own respective name or jointly with other entities. Accordingly, Broker acting in its capacity as a broker may submit competing proposals from other sellers to prospective customers, and prospective customers may seek proposals directly from WGES during the term of this Agreement.

3. **WGES' OBLIGATIONS.** WGES shall in a timely manner provide Broker with retail electricity, renewable energy credits and/or natural gas price quotes that shall include Brokerage Fees that comply with Paragraph 4 below. In connection with providing such price quotes to Broker, WGES agrees to perform the following in a timely manner:

(a) WGES shall execute contracts executed by customers who have selected WGES price quotes provided to Broker hereunder; provided that WGES shall have the sole right to determine whether or not to execute a contract with a customer based on a price quote provided to Broker, to enforce the terms and conditions of the contract and to terminate any such contract for non-payment.

(b) WGES shall enroll such contracts with the applicable utility, and

(c) WGES shall administer the contracts and bill the customer during the term of the customer's contract.

4. BROKERAGE FEES. WGES agrees to compensate Broker for contracts executed by customers pursuant to this Agreement and in accordance with Brokerage Fees set forth in Addenda executed by Broker and WGES.

(a) WGES shall pay Brokerage Fees that are included in WGES price quotes provided to Broker and accepted by customers in contracts for specific customer accounts. Broker agrees that Brokerage Fees shall be subject to review by WGES and shall be set forth in separately executed Addenda to this Agreement.

(b) That Brokerage Fees are included in price quotes WGES provided to Broker shall be acknowledged in contracts and confirmations executed by customers that accept such quotes. Brokerage Fees shall be payable (on a quarterly basis as specified in Section c below) for each electricity kilowatt hour (kWh), renewable energy credit and/or natural gas (them) delivered by WGES to the specific accounts during the applicable terms of executed confirmations, subject to the receipt by WGES of payments from the customers for usage.

(c) WGES shall pay Broker within thirty (30) business days after the end of each calendar quarter during the calendar year. Payments shall be based on utility meter readings that have been received by WGES prior to the end of the applicable calendar quarter. In the case of cancelled and subsequently re-billed usage, WGES shall make payment adjustments to reflect the period that usage is received. All payments shall be subject to reduction to reflect Brokerage Fees previously paid for any prior quarter where customer payments have not been received.

(d) If Broker fails to obtain or maintain a brokerage license required by a public service commission where a customer with an executed contract obtained hereunder is located, WGES shall have the right to terminate this agreement for cause, and Broker shall not have the right to payment for Brokerage Fees in contracts in such jurisdiction(s).

(e) If a customer seeks protection under federal or state bankruptcy laws or is otherwise forced into a bankruptcy proceeding by its creditors, and as a result of an order or other bankruptcy court action, the customer pays WGES less than the full amount due under the customer's contract with WGES, any Brokerage Fee payments to Broker hereunder shall be reduced commensurately.

(f) If Broker violates any provision of this Agreement, including but not limited to, representing itself as an agent of WGES in presenting bids to customers or as being able to alter, or promising to alter, a term or condition in the standard WGES sales contract, then, in addition to its obligation under Paragraph 1 (b), Broker shall forfeit any Brokerage Fee payments related to such contracts and shall be liable for the return of any previously paid Brokerage Fee payments.

5. TERM. This Agreement shall be for an initial term of twelve months beginning on the Effective Date and shall remain in effect month to month thereafter, unless either Party terminates this Agreement for cause pursuant Paragraph 6 or by giving the other Party thirty days written notice of termination pursuant to Paragraph 8. In the event this Agreement is terminated, WGES shall continue to pay Fees specified in executed Addenda that are in effect at the date of termination.

6. TERMINATION FOR CAUSE. Either Party may terminate this Agreement immediately upon written notice if the other Party has: (a) falsified information that underlies this Agreement; (b) is found to be conducting its business in a manner which is not proper or which is illegal; (c) materially breaches this Agreement or any of its obligations hereunder; or (d) is unable to pay its debts generally as they come due, is declared insolvent or bankrupt, is the subject of any proceedings relating to its liquidation, insolvency or the appointment of a receiver or similar officer, makes an assignment for the benefit of all, or substantially all, of its creditors, or enters into an agreement for the composition, extension, or readjustment of all or substantially all of its obligations.

7. TERMINATION FOR CHANGES IN LAWS OR REGULATIONS. Either Party shall have the right to terminate this Agreement, without liability to the other, in the event that any judicial, regulatory, or legislative action makes a change in applicable law or regulation that renders the affected Party's performance under this Agreement impossible, illegal, or economically impracticable. The affected Party shall provide the other with written notice of such termination as promptly as possible, but in no event less than five (5) days prior to the termination date.

8. **TERMINATION FOR OTHER REASONS.** Either Party may terminate this Agreement for any reason upon thirty (30) days prior written notice to the other.

10. **GOVERNING LAW.** This Agreement shall be governed by, and construed in accordance, with the laws of the State of Maryland.

11. **CONFIDENTIALITY.** The Parties agree to maintain the confidentiality of all information provided by WGES to Broker and by Broker to WGES hereunder, including information pertaining to pricing, price quotes, brokerage fees, contracts, products, and marketing activities ("Confidential Information") which is identified as Confidential Information in writing when provided. Broker shall be entitled to disclose such Confidential Information to customers or prospective customers, provided however, Broker shall have no responsibility or liability to WGES should a customer or prospective customer disclose such Confidential Information to others. Except as provided above, the Parties agree not to disclose any Confidential Information to any third party without the prior written consent of the non-disclosing Party. The term "Confidential Information" does not include information that (i) is part of the public domain; (ii) becomes part of the public domain other than as a result of a disclosure by a Party in breach of this Agreement; (iii) was known to the non-disclosing Party prior to disclosure and (iv) is required to be disclosed by a court or governmental agency which exercises appropriate jurisdiction over the disclosing Party.

12. **ASSIGNMENT AND AMENDMENT.** This Agreement shall be binding upon the heirs, successors, and assigns of the Parties hereto. Neither Party may assign this Agreement without the written consent of the other Party. This Agreement may not be altered or amended in any way except in writing signed by both Parties.

13. **ENTIRE AGREEMENT.** This Agreement constitutes the entire agreement of the Parties, supercedes all the prior fee agreements between the Parties, and no oral agreements shall be considered part of this Agreement.

14. **INDEPENDENT CONTRACTOR.** Broker is an independent contractor, not an employee of WGES, and WGES will not provide Broker with fringe benefits, paid vacation, or any other employee benefit.


15. **INDEMNIFICATION.** Each Party (an Indemnifying Party) agrees to indemnify the other Party (the Indemnified Party) and hold the Indemnified Party and its officers, directors, shareholders, agents and employees harmless from any and all claims, losses, liabilities, damages, costs, expenses, and judgments that may result from any negligent acts or willful misconduct of the indemnifying Party hereunder, subject to the following:

(b) EACH PARTY SHALL INDEMNIFY THE OTHER FOR ANY CLAIM OR ACTION BROUGHT BY A THIRD PARTY FOR BREACH OF A DUTY ASSUMED HEREUNDER, AND EXCEPT TO THE EXTENT NECESSARY TO FULLFILL SUCH INDEMNITY OBLIGATIONS, AND EXCEPT FOR A BREACH OF SECTION 13 REGARDING CONFIDENTIALITY, NEITHER PARTY SHALL BE LIABLE TO THE OTHER FOR ANY SPECIAL, INDIRECT, INCIDENTAL, EXEMPLARY, CONSEQUENTIAL OR PUNITIVE DAMAGES OF ANY CHARACTER, IRRESPECTIVE OF WHETHER CLAIMS OR ACTIONS FOR SUCH DAMAGES ARE BASED UPON CONTRACT, WARRANTY, NEGLIGENCE, STRICT LIABILITY OR ANY OTHER REMEDY AT LAW OR EQUITY. Each party shall pay its own attorney fees.

16. **INSURANCE.** During the effectiveness of this Agreement, Broker stipulates that in compliance with all applicable federal and state laws it has, or shall obtain, all required workers compensation, business liability and auto insurance coverage with respect to its brokerage activities hereunder.

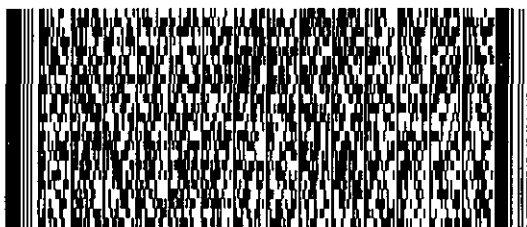
