Dear Secretary Chiavetta,

On November 6, 2010, David A. Parrendo filed a letter that was labeled a
"Reply to Exceptions A-2010-2159814." In that letter, he concurred with Paul
Jenkins' Exceptions. Duquesne Light Company does not consider that letter to
be valid Reply Exceptions to the Initial Decision in this Application. Duquesne
Light Company will limit its response to this letter.

Procedurally, Mr. Parrendo lacks standing to file reply exceptions. He has not
filed a written request for leave to intervene in accordance with 52 Pa. §57.75.
Therefore, he is not a party in the sense of 52 Pa. §5.533(a).

On a practical matter, Mr. Parrendo's concerns mirror those of Mr. Jenkins.
Duquesne Light's Reply Exceptions that were filed on November 8, 2010 are in
response to Mr. Jenkins' Exceptions, but they also address the issues raised in
Mr. Parrendo's letter.
