**MOTION FOR CONTINUANCE OF HEARING**


Pursuant to 52 Pa. Code § 1.15(b), Philadelphia Gas Works, the Respondent (PGW) hereby requests a continuance of the hearing in this matter scheduled for Wednesday, December 1, 2010. In support of its motion, PGW states as follows:

1. On July 6, 2010, the Commission served the Respondent with the Complaint filed in the above-captioned matter (which is a billing dispute).
2. On July 26, 2010, PGW filed an Answer to the Complaint in the above-captioned matter.
3. By Notice dated September 16, 2010, the Commission scheduled an In-Person Hearing in this matter on December 1, 2010 at 10:00 a.m. before Administrative Law Judge Christopher P. Pell in the Commission's Philadelphia office.
4. The Respondent discovered on November 24, 2010 that there is an additional issue at the service address that requires further investigation.
5. PGW also believes that there is a possibility that the parties will resolve the instant matter by settlement as the parties have agreed to discuss the issues further.


