1. The above-captioned Formal Complaint is scheduled for hearing before Administrative Law Judge Conrad A. Johnson on Thursday, December 2, 2010 at 10:00 a.m.
2. In accordance with Judge Johnson's Prehearing Order dated September 2, 2010, Respondent contacted Complainant by telephone on November 24, 2010.
3. The parties exchanged messages and brief conversations but were not able to have a sustained discussion until December 1, 2010 at 2:00 p.m.
4. As a result of the settlement discussion, Respondent will perform a meter test on Complainant's meter for the standard \$20 fee. The parties hope


that the information from the meter test will facilitate further settlement discussions, and possible settlement of the Formal Complaint without a hearing.
