JOINT STIPULATION FOR ADMISSION OF EVIDENCE

TO ADMINISTRATIVE LAW JUDGE CHRISTOPHER P. PELL:

Superior Water Company, Inc. d/b/a Superior Water Company (“Superior”), the Office of Trial Staff (“OTS”) of the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission (“Commission”), and the Office of Consumer Advocate (“OCA”) (collectively the “Parties”) file this Proposed Stipulation for Admission of Evidence in the above-captioned proceeding (“Evidence Stipulation”). In support of the Evidence Stipulation, the Parties represent as follows:

1. Paragraphs 1 through 22 regarding the “Procedural History” of the Joint Petition for Approval of Settlement (“Joint Petition”) submitted on this same date in the above-captioned proceeding are hereby incorporated by reference.

2. In conjunction with the submission of the Joint Petition, the Parties have entered into this Evidence Stipulation with regard to admission by stipulation of the following testimony and accompanying exhibits into the record:

- a. **Superior Water Company Statement No. 1.** Direct Testimony of Louise A. Knight, Chief Operating Officer of Superior.
- b. **Superior Water Company Statement No. 2.** Direct Testimony of Dennis M. Kalbarczyk, Consultant, Utility Rate Resources, which includes Superior Water Company Exhibit No. DMK-1.
- c. **Superior Water Company Statement No. 1 (Supp.).** Supplemental Direct Testimony of Louise A. Knight, Chief Operating Officer of Superior.
- d. **Superior Water Company Statement No. 2 (Supp.).** Supplemental Direct Testimony of Dennis M. Kalbarczyk, Consultant, Utility Rate Resources, which includes Superior Water Company Exhibit No. DMK-1.1.

The Parties stipulate as to the authenticity of the foregoing testimony and accompanying exhibits. Copies of the testimony and exhibits are being filed with the Commission’s Secretary for inclusion in the official case record upon approval of this Evidence Stipulation.

3. The admission by stipulation of the foregoing testimony and exhibits is subject to approval of the Joint Petition by Your Honor and the Commission. As set forth in the Joint Petition, the Parties reserve their respective rights to submit further testimony and to cross examine witnesses in the event that the settlement is not approved.


