Reliant Energy Northeast LLC (REN) is sending this letter which provides the following information regarding our EGS License as it pertains to the Allegheny service territory in Pennsylvania.

- REN filed an application to serve as an EGS provider in the state of Pennsylvania on August 4, 2010.
 - In answer to question #9 of the application REN expressed the desire to provide services throughout the entire state of Pennsylvania.
 - In answer to question #10 of the application REN did not specifically mention the geographic area of Allegheny as a service area it was then proposing to serve.
- REN published the required notice in the following newspapers: Philadelphia Inquirer, Pittsburgh Post-Gazette, Scranton Times, The Patriot News, Erie Times-News and Williamsport Sun Gazette. These publications covered the entire state, including the Allegheny service area. REN provided a Publication Affidavit and supporting documentation to the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission (PAPUC) on August 31, 2010.
- REN was approved at the PAPUC open meeting on October 14, 2010 as a licensed electric generation supplier (EGS) in the service territories of Allegheny Power, Duquesne Light Company, Metropolitan Edison Company, Pennsylvania Electric Company, PECO Energy Company, Pennsylvania Power Company, PPL Electric Utilities, Inc., and UGI Utilities, Inc.-Electric Division, within the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania. Since the Commission Order approved REN as an EGS for the entire state, rather than ask REN to re-file an entire application just for Allegheny's service territory, the Commission Staff asked REN to send Allegheny a letter with supporting documentation to assure Allegheny has the necessary information regarding REN's Registration.



To that end, enclosed, please find a completed Electric Generation Supplier Registration form for Reliant Energy Northeast LLC (REN).

REN requests to participate in EDI supplier testing and other retail electric generation supplier functions in the West Penn (AP) service area. REN requests that EDI testing begin once our registration package is approved by Allegheny.

- REN has included a copy of the Letter of Credit previously provided in Maryland for the Allegheny service area. Per the West Penn Electric Generation Supplier Coordination Tariff only one Letter of Credit is needed for all Alleghany service areas.


