AND NOW, Robert Van Orden, by and through his counsel, Marakay J. Rogers, Esquire, brings this response to the New Matter raised by Metropolitan Edison Company as follows:

11. Admitted.

12. Admitted in Part, denied in part. The complainant acknowledges that he received services at the Jackson service location between those dates approximately. The Complainant denies that he made only one payment on the account on the grounds that though he did not use his own personal funds to pay his bill, he sought and received assistance from programs such as LIHEAP which awarded him cash grants and crisis grants. He also received help from the Salvation Army as well as churches in the area that sent money to Met-Ed to be credited to his account and to be used to pay his Met-Ed bill.

13. Admitted. It is admitted that the Complainant received electric service at this location between these dates approximately, as well as that he filed a Chapter 13 bankruptcy at approximately the date given.

16. Denied. Though funds may not have come directly from Complainant, payments were made to his account by LIHEAP, area churches, and the Salvation Army that all sent money to Met-Ed to be used to pay Complainant's bills.


