My name is Cheryl Wilson and my PUC # is A-00123534 and I would like to ask for a reconsideration of the fine adjudicated. I have talked with Robert Bingham and explained the situation to him. I thought this whole matter was taken care of by my insurance agent at Weaver's insurance agency back in April of this year. When I received the letter of 4/2/10 from the PUC, I called our insurance agent and faxed the correspondence to him and he said that he would take care of it. I assumed that this was done, since I did not receive any other communication from the PUC. Then I received a letter from the PUC near the end of September re: a complaint being filed which included a fin of \$500.00. I called my insurance agent again and faxed him the letter and he said that he would send the necessary information again... The form E was sent to the PUC but was returned because it was incorrect. I called my agent again and faxed him the letter and a corrected form was sent. I received a letter around 10/27/10 lifting the suspension of my PUC operating authority.

When I talked to Robert, I questioned the five month gap in correspondence re: this whole situation the form E. He said that we were given ample time in which to comply. Since I had not heard anything for 5 months, I assumed we were in compliance. I would think that some follow-up would have been required within that 5 month period. I am so confused and upset about this whole situation I do not know what to do or where to turn next. Would calling the Governor's office help? I am still working with the insurance company to try to straighten this out.

I hope this letter makes some sense and explains why I am upset and confused with the time frame of this situation. I wanted to do the right thing by getting my PUC authority and not doing like most of the people who drive the Amish by doing it illegally. There seems to be no consequences to not complying with the law.

I want to thank you for taking the time to read this letter and would appreciate anything that you can do. I cannot afford to pay a \$500 fine.
