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

**PETITION TO WITHDRAW
INTERVENTION OF DOMINION RETAIL, INC.**

AND NOW, comes Dominion Retail, Inc. ("Dominion Retail") by and through its counsel, Hawke McKeon & Sniscak LLP, and hereby Petitions the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission to Withdraw its Intervention in the above-captioned matters pursuant to 52 Pa. Code, § 5.94(a). The reason for the request to withdraw is that the parties have reached a settlement that resolves the issues raised in this matter in a manner that is satisfactory to Dominion Retail. The agreement is reflected in the revised tariffs filed by Metropolitan Edison Company ("Met-Ed") and Pennsylvania Electric Company ("Penelec") (collectively "the Companies") on December 30, 2010, with a proposed effective date of January 15, 2011. In support of the Petition to Withdraw, Dominion Retail states and avers as follows:

1. On or about March 31, 2010, Met-Ed filed Tariff Electric Pa. P.U.C. No. S-1 and Penelec filed Tariff Electric Pa. P.U.C. No. S-1 (collectively "Supplier Tariffs"). The Companies' Supplier Tariffs had an effective date of January 1, 2011.

2. The Supplier Tariffs proposed significant and far-reaching changes to the rules and requirements of electric generation suppliers (“EGS”) operating on the Met-Ed and Penelec systems.

3. On May 21, 2010, the Retail Energy Supply Association (“RESA”) filed Complaints against the Supplier Tariffs.

4. On May 25, 2010, Dominion Retail filed a Petition to Intervene in the tariff filing proceeding and in the RESA Complaint proceedings. In its Petition to Intervene, Dominion Retail concurred in RESA’s Complaint and stated that the RESA Complaint “. . . raises legitimate concerns about the tariff supplements filed by Met-Ed and Penelec . . .” Dominion Complaint at ¶ 6.

5. Since the filing of the complaint, the parties have worked to informally resolve the issues raised by the RESA Complaint and other issues of concern with regard to the Supplier Tariffs. Those negotiations were fruitful, and by letter dated December 23, 2010, the Companies proposed to extend the effective date of the Supplier Tariffs from January 1 to January 15 to allow the parties to continue their settlement discussions and to finalize the tariff filing.

6. The parties finally agreed on revisions to the tariff language and established a further process for discussion regarding items that could not be resolved through language proposed in the December 30, 2010 filing made by the Companies. However, the parties agree that the revised Supplier Tariffs should go into effect on January 15, 2011, with the understanding that the Companies would continue to discuss the “open issues.”

7. Accordingly, Dominion Retail believes that it is appropriate to terminate this proceeding, allowing the revised Supplier Tariffs to become effective at the earliest possible date, and withdraws its Petition to Intervene to facilitate that eventuality. Moreover, Dominion

Retail hereby states its NON-OBJECTION to the withdrawal of RESA's Complaint in the above-captioned matter subject to the conditions discussed in RESA's Petition to Withdraw Complaint, filed December 31, 2010.

8. Moreover, Dominion Retail's withdrawal of its Petition to Intervene is without prejudice to its ability to initiate any further proceedings in the future regarding any revisions to Met-Ed or Penelec's Supplier Tariffs or in any future proceeding.

WHEREFORE, Dominion Retail respectfully requests that its Intervention in the above-captioned proceeding be withdrawn and that the Supplier Tariffs filed by Met-Ed and Penelec on December 30, 2010, be allowed to become effective as of January 15, 2011.
