1. Complainants are John Prehart and Ken Prehart.
2. Respondent is PPL Electric Utilities Corporation (hereafter "PPL").
3. This Certificate of Satisfaction of Complaint is submitted pursuant to 52 Pa. Code §5.24(b).

4. PPL hereby certifies that the parties to the above-referenced formal Complaint, now pending before the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission, have mutually and voluntarily agreed on the following terms as full satisfaction of all outstanding legal and factual disputes in this proceeding, and Complaint has acknowledged satisfaction to PPL:

(a) Complainants, John Prehart and Ken Prehart, and Respondent, PPL, agree that Complainant has an outstanding, overdue balance of \$7,532.78. Beginning with the payment due April 13, 2011, Complainant agrees to pay each month's current bill plus \$300 per month towards arrearages, until all arrearages are paid in full (with the first payment of \$656.65 to be paid on or before April 13, 2011). So long as timely monthly payments are made, PPL will not assess any interest or penalties. In the

event payments are less than the full amount or timely, PPL may terminate the payment arrangement, with the entire balance becoming due and payable.


(c) Complainants withdraw their Complaint.
