Exceptions in the above captioned mater:

1. On or about August 23, 2010, Complainant filed a Formal Complaint against PECO requesting a payment agreement.
2. By hearing notice dated September 14, 2010, a hearing was scheduled for January 18, 2011. On January 18, 2011, the hearing convened as scheduled.
3. On Wednesday, March 23, 2011 an Initial Decision (ID) was issued in this matter.





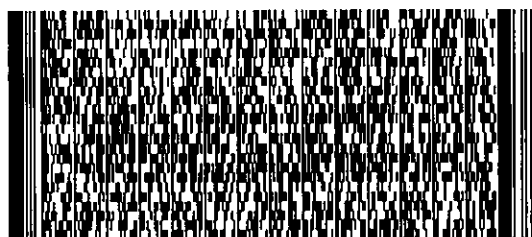
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
