Re: Docket Number: A-2010-2162977, Amendment to ConocoPhillips Company's (COP) Electric Generation Supplier (EGS) License

Dear Ms. Chiavetta,

COP respectfully requests the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission (PUC) approve an amendment to its current EGS license so that COP may sell electricity and related services throughout the entire state of Pennsylvania, and specifically sell to Commercial Customers over 25 kW, Industrial Customers, and Governmental Customers under the provisions of the Electricity Generation Customer Choice and Competition Act.

COP understands from the PUC's recent Secretarial Letter regarding mixed meter scenarios (dated March 25, 2011, and issued in Docket No. M-2009-2082042), that if an EGS incidentally serves Commercial Customers 25 kW or under or Residential Customers as a result of serving Commercial Customers over 25 kW, Industrial Customers, or Governmental Customers, the EGS must amend its license to obtain permission to serve such customers.

At this time, COP intends to serve only Commercial Customers over 25 kW, Industrial Customers, and Governmental Customers, but to the extent that smaller Commercial (25 kW and under) and/or Residential Customers may be served incidentally with its larger customers, COP seeks approval to serve such smaller Commercial and Residential Customers. However, COP has no present intention to separately serve any Residential Customers or Commercial Customers 25 kW or below in the state of Pennsylvania.
