Dear Secretary Chiavetta,

I do not wish to close the satisfaction certificate. I responded directly to PECO regarding the Satisfaction certificate that I was not satisfied with the work done by Asplundh. This work done by Asplundh to remove the trees and stumps that were destroyed by over-pruning (by Asplundh), left the lawn with two mounds of dirt/rocks and an area that needs to be re-sodded. I spoke with Teresa Sanborn who declined to complete the repair of my damaged property. It is only fair that in causing damage by removing the trees which were a natural and beautiful part of my landscaped lawn that the lawn should be properly restored to some reasonable and acceptable condition. A minimal repair would be to remove the existing layer of topsoil that contains rocks and debris from the stump grinding, to level the area and to apply sod. To do this a landscaper wanted to charge me \$500.00.

Please advise what steps will need to be taken in the interim so that this can be completed before summer rolls around and sod is not able to be planted.

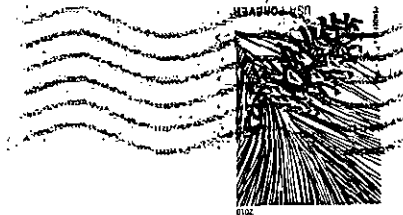
