Dear Mr. Lipuma:

On October 8, 2010, the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission Bureau of Transportation & Safety (BTS) filed a complaint against Respondent, Brookville Limousine Service LLC, alleging that the Company did not provide this Commission with a current list of all of its vehicles utilized under its limousine authority for the years 2006, 2007, 2008, and 2009. By letters received January 11, 2011, Respondent answered the complaint stating that the Commission had constructive notice of its vehicle since the Company must request a special exemption because its vehicle is older than 8 years. In addition, the Respondent provided the year, make, vehicle identification number, and registration number of its vehicle recognizing that 52 Pa. Code § 29.333 (d) requires that the carrier must provide a separate vehicle list every year. Therefore, based upon Respondent's answer, the BTS, by and through its counsel, hereby withdraws the subject complaint. Respondent and any other interested party has 20 days within which to file an objection to this withdrawal of the complaint.
