
Dear Secretary Chiavetta:

Since considerably before December 6 of 2010, I have been unable to send email messages Eranda Vero, Special Agent in the Office of the Administrative Law Judge. 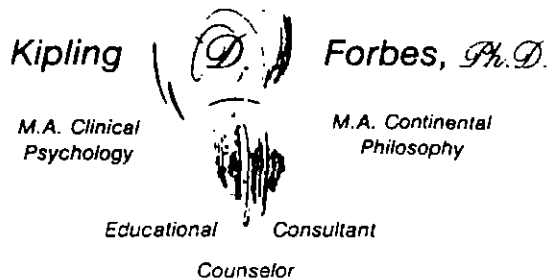





AND THE HONORABLE COMMISSION:



- (b) For a continuance which would allow sufficient time for discovery.

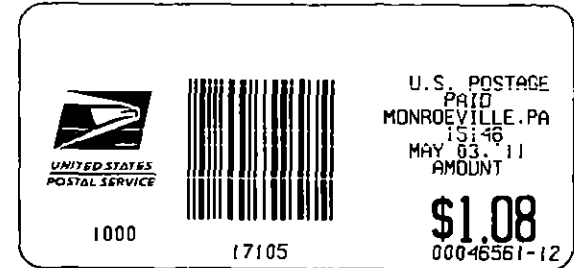
