**RESPONDENT DUQUESNE LIGHT COMPANY'S
MOTION FOR CONTINUANCE**

TO THE HONORABLE COMMISSION:

AND NOW comes Respondent, Duquesne Light Company, by and through its attorney, Krysia Kubiak, and files this Motion for Continuance in accordance with Commission Regulation 5.103, 52 Pa. Code §5.103:

1. Complainant filed the above-captioned Formal Complaint on or about April 21, 2011.
2. An Answer is due on May 11, 2011.
3. The parties are attempting to resolve this dispute, and Complainant consents to this motion.
4. Said Formal Complaint concerns high bills that Complainant has received from December of 2010 to the present.

5. Respondent has made multiple visits to Complainant's residence to investigate the situation. Most recently, on Friday, May 6, 2011, Respondent's representatives Bill Robinson and Ed Keegan went to Complainant's residence and met with Complainant.

6. The parties believe that the problem has been identified, and that a resolution of the above-captioned Formal Complaint is forthcoming.

7. Before a final settlement can be reached, Respondent must verify certain information. In order to do this, Respondent must access other areas of Complainant's apartment building.

8. Respondent is in the process of obtaining access the areas in question of Complainant's apartment building. Respondent has been in contact with the property manager and another tenant in the building, but, to-date, has not secured the access that it needs to complete its investigation.


9. The parties expect that a final settlement will be reached within 20 days. In the alternative, if a settlement is not possible, Respondent will be able to file an Answer within 20 days.


