OF THE OFFICE OF SMALL BUSINESS ADVOCATE**





**PUBLIC STATEMENT**

The Small Business Advocate is authorized and directed to represent the interest of small business consumers of utility services in Pennsylvania under the provisions of the Small Business Advocate Act, Act 181 of 1988, 73 P.S. §§ 399.41 - 399.50 (“Act”). The Act further provides that the Small Business Advocate is to issue publicly a written statement stating concisely the specific interest of small business consumers to be protected by his initiation of or intervention in any proceeding involving those interests before the Public Utility Commission (“Commission”) or any other agency or court. This public statement relates to the filing today by the Small Business Advocate of a Notice of Intervention with respect to the Final 2011 Generation Supply Charge-1 Reconciliation Report filed by PPL Electric Utilities Corporation (“PPL” or the “Company”) with the Commission on May 13, 2011.

The Small Business Advocate is intervening in this case in order to protect the interests of the Company’s small business customers. Specifically, the Small Business Advocate is intervening to preserve its rights with respect to its Complaint filed on May 31, 2011 (the “OSBA Complaint”), at Docket No. M-2011-2243137, regarding PPL’s Calculation of Generation Supply Charge-1 for the application period June 1, 2011, through August 31, 2011.

In view of the foregoing, the Small Business Advocate will participate in proceedings before the Commission to ensure that the outcome of such proceedings are without prejudice to the OSBA Complaint.
