OF THE OFFICE OF SMALL BUSINESS ADVOCATE**





**PUBLIC STATEMENT OF  
THE OFFICE OF SMALL BUSINESS ADVOCATE**

The Small Business Advocate is authorized and directed to represent the interest of small business consumers of utility services in Pennsylvania under the provisions of the Small Business Advocate Act, Act 181 of 1988, 73 P.S. §§ 399.41 - 399.50 (the "Act"). The Act further provides that the Small Business Advocate is to issue publicly a written statement stating concisely the specific interest of small business consumers to be protected by his initiation of or intervention in any proceeding involving those interests before the Public Utility Commission (the "Commission") or any other agency or court. This public statement relates to the filing today by the Small Business Advocate of a Notice of Intervention with respect to the proceedings commenced by PPL Electric Utilities Corporation's ("PPL" or the "Company") filing of its Proposed Transmission Service Charge ("TSC") Reconciliation for the Twelve Months Ending November 30, 2010, on December 10, 2010.

The Small Business Advocate files this Notice of Intervention in order to protect the interests of the Company's small business customers. The Commission entered an order in this proceeding on May 19, 2011, which raised the possibility of a change in the allocation of TSC costs among rate classes. A change in allocation could adversely affect the Company's small business customers.

In view of the foregoing, the Small Business Advocate will participate in proceedings before the Commission to investigate the reasonableness and lawfulness of the proposed TSC reconciliation.
