Application of Interstate Gas Supply, Inc. (d/b/a "IGS Energy") For Approval To Offer, Render, Furnish Or Supply Electricity Or Electric Generation Services As A Supplier Of Electric Power To The Public In The Commonwealth Of Pennsylvania.

On March 2, 2011, Interstate Gas Supply, Inc. ("IGS") filed an application with the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission ("PUC") for a license to supply electricity or electric generation services as a supplier of electric power engaged in the business of supplying electricity, under the provisions of the new Electricity Generation Customer Choice and Competition Act, in the service territory of PECO Energy Company. IGS's application was approved by the PUC on May 19, 2011. IGS has recently filed a request with the PUC to amend its application to provide service in the service territories of PPL and Duquesne Light Company.

The PUC may consider this request without a hearing. Protests directed to the technical or financial fitness of IGS may be filed within 15 days of the date of this notice with the Secretary of the PUC, P.O. Box 3265, Harrisburg, PA 17105-3265.
