Sample Disclosure Statement

Disclosure Statement for YEP Energy

This is an agreement for electric generation service from YEP Energy (“YEP”) for residential and small commercial customers, as applicable*.

Background

We at YEP are licensed by the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission to offer and supply electric generation services in Pennsylvania. Our PUC license number is A-2011-XXXXXXX. YEP sets the generation prices and charges that you pay. The Public Utility Commission regulates distribution prices and services. The Federal Energy Regulatory Commission regulates transmission prices and services. You will receive a single bill that will contain Electric Distribution Company (“EDC”) charges and YEP charges. Generation prices and charges are set by the electric generation supplier you have chosen. The Public Utility Commission regulates distribution prices and services. The Federal Energy Regulatory Commission regulates transmission prices and services.

Right of Rescission - You may cancel this agreement at any time before midnight of the third business day after receiving this disclosure either orally, in writing or electronically at the contact information found below.

Definitions

Generation Charge - Charge for production of electricity.

Transmission Charge - Charge for moving high voltage electricity from a generation facility to the distribution lines of an EDC.

Distribution Charge – Charge for delivering electricity over a distribution system to the home or business from the transmission system.

Terms of Service

1. **Basic Service Prices** - YEP will always offer you its lowest price possible through its Fixed Price and Variable Price Service Plans. Pricing and plans are available 24 hours a day at www.yepenergyPA.com or contact Customer Care for more information. YEP will not offer any non-basic services.
 - a. **Fixed Rate Service** - You will pay _____ per kWh for electric generation service during your initial term. You will have the ability to renew at a low fixed rate prior to the expiration of your term. Upon expiration of your term, YEP will continue to provide service to you on a month to month basis at the then current variable rate.
 - b. **Variable Rate Service** - You will pay _____ per kWh for electric generation service during your first month of service. Following the first month of service, your rate may fluctuate and is subject to change at the sole discretion of YEP based on the prevailing market price. Your variable rate may change based upon the fluctuation of wholesale natural gas prices or other market factors effecting wholesale electric prices.

2. Length of Agreement

You will buy your electricity generation service for your service address (as selected by you during your enrollment) from YEP beginning on the effective date as determined by your EDC through the end of your contracted term. Variable Rate Service Plans will run on a month to month basis.

3. **Special Terms and Conditions** – YEP includes an auto-pay discount of 0.5¢/kWh for each and every kWh consumed and paid for by the customer. Customers electing to enroll in automatic payments can make payments through their bank or financial institution or by credit card.

4. Penalties, Fees and Exceptions – YEP will add a late fee of 5 % to any balance that is not satisfied prior to the due date on the invoice.

5. Cancellation Provisions – YEP will not charge any termination fee for month to month customers. YEP will charge an early termination fee in the amount of \$175 to any customer for cancellation of their service Agreement with YEP prior to the end of their term. Such fee shall be assessed on those customers that have their agreements terminated due to non-payment.

6. Renewal Provision/Agreement Expiration/Change in Terms

If you have a fixed term agreement with us and it is approaching the expiration date or whenever we propose to change our terms of service in any type of agreement, you will receive written notification from us in each of our last three bills for supply charges or in corresponding separate mailings that precede either the expiration date or the effective date of the proposed changes. We will explain your options to you in these three advance notifications.

7. Dispute Procedures

Contact us with any questions concerning our terms of service. You may call the PUC if you are not satisfied after discussing your terms with us.
