RESOLUTION NO. 07-05-11

A RESOLUTION IN SUPPORT OF THE PENNSYLVANIA PUBLIC UTILITY COMMISSION PLAN TO SPLIT THE 814 AREA CODE

WHEREAS, on December 16, 2010, the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission (PUC) approved a plan to split the 814 area code along geographic boundaries to avoid running out of telephone numbers: and

WHEREAS, the geographical boundaries to be used by the PUC in splitting the 814 area code are set forth on the map ("Map") attached hereto as Exhibit "A" and incorporated herein by this reference, which said Map is provided on the PUC website at www.puc.state.pa.us; and

WHEREAS, the said Map clearly indicates that all of Bedford County, Pennsylvania shall retain the 814 area code after said split; and

WHEREAS, the Township of East Providence agrees with and supports the PUC decision and Map which allows East Providence Township and Bedford County as a whole, to retain the 814 area code.

NOW THEREFORE. BE IT RESOLVED, and the same is hereby resolved by the Board of Supervisors of the Township of East Providence, that said Board steadfastly supports the Plan and Map adopted by the PUC to split the 814 area code to allow East Providence Township and Bedford County as a whole to retain the said 814 area code.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that Board of Supervisors of East Providence Township urges the PUC not to make any changes to its approved plan to split the 814 area code.






