The Post Office is suppose to be the one that is accurate, with them being the Post Office and all - but I just wanted to let you know what they told me, in case you would want to look in to it. They did tell me that they believe though that you would get whatever I sent to you with the zip code I used. Just to let you know about that while I was writing you.

Dear Judge Barnes:

I am writing to you in response to this Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission's Hearing Cancellation/Reschedule Notice letter to me dated 3/22/11 (See attached copy of it for your reference), regarding the Hearing Cancellation/Reschedule Notice of the above Docket Numbers Hearing that has been scheduled for Friday, May 6, 2011.

I am writing to you because I have decided to withdraw my Formal Complaints with the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission for the above Docket Numbers. I am withdrawing in an "UNSATISFIED STATUS"-

I feel too much time has gone by - It has been approximately 1 YEAR since I first filed my Formal Complaints with the Commission - Many things would not be fresh in minds anymore about all I've documented to everyone and I feel this is all just really complicated, with being "2" separate Dockets, etc. - and I just feel overwhelmed with the detail and complication of all of it - and not supported or respected and I do not feel well enough to proceed on with this, because I do not want to continue on with this abuse that I feel that it is, relating to untrue statements being said, etc. and it is much complication with the details of all the facts, etc. - and I do feel my complaints were about some other things, coupled with billing/not just billing as it states - you should be able to see this, by reading all of the mailings of letters of complaints I've sent over this past year about everything.

Just to comment here also: In the paperwork for the original Hearing Notice for the Initial Hearing - on the 2nd page of that mailing - there were other paragraphs talking about other things - but on this May 6, 2011 Hearing Cancellation/Reschedule Notice - on the 2nd page - they are not listing a number of these paragraphs?? I'll send you the copy to show you what I'm referring to - which I'm sure you know - but I do not know why on this Reschedule Notice that they don't have these paragraphs on the 2nd page that they had on the 2nd page with the original Hearing Notice's paperwork. I do not know why. Maybe they feel that since I was informed of those paragraphs on the original Hearing Notice, that they did not need to put those paragraphs in this Reschedule Notice?? But, I do feel if those paragraphs were in one Hearing Notice, that they should also be in any other Hearing Notice, if it is to be stated to people. That is my feeling about that. But anyways, it stated on page 2 of this 3/17/11 Hearing Notice letter about the Presiding Officer being served with copies of documents - AND IT ALSO STATED - about exhibits being filed, being submitted to the reporter - I feel all my complaint letters that I have sent to P.O. BOX 3265 Harrisburg, PA should be copied and forwarded to whoever would need them for any Hearing - I should not have had to send any more copies of anything to anyone - ALSO, as far as file exhibits, I'm not sure EXACTLY what that means - I think I have an idea - but I'm not sure - BUT - it said about submitting to reporter (I do not even know who the reporter is) - the Hearing Notice letters do not say anywhere in them who the reporter is - So, I do not even know who the reporter is - I do not feel that I should have been asked to send any more copies of anything else because I've already sent all my letters of complaints, that should have been able to be forwarded on to whoever would need them for a Hearing. Just wanted to express my comments about these paragraphs on page 2 of the original Hearing Notice you sent me - but you do not have these paragraphs on page 2 on this Rescheduled Notice you now sent.


