On January 18, 2011, Mr. William McAllister, (“Complainant”) left a voicemail at the undersigned’s office. The substance of the message was that the Complainant is not planning to attend the scheduled Initial Hearing of his formal complaint at Docket No. F-2010-2177366 against Philadelphia Gas Works.

The undersigned appreciates the notice the Complainant has given of his intentions regarding the adjudication of his formal complaint. It is reiterated that Complainant may lose his case if he fails to take part in the scheduled hearing and fails to present evidence on the issues raised. See William McAllister v. Philadelphia Gas Works, Prehearing Order, Docket No. F-2010-2177366, December 15, 2010, at 2, ¶ 3. If Complainant desires to withdraw his formal complaint, he must file with the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission a Petition for Leave to Withdraw the formal complaint which is to be served on opposing counsel and the undersigned. See 52 Pa. Code § 5.94(a). If Complainant fails to file a Petition for Leave to Withdraw the formal complaint, the undersigned will expect the Complainant to appear at the scheduled Initial Hearing on Wednesday, February 9, 2011, at 10:00 am.
