The Act further provides that the Small Business Advocate is to issue publicly a written statement stating concisely the specific interest of small business consumers to be protected by his initiation of or intervention in any proceeding involving those interests before the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission (the "Commission") or any other agency or court. This public statement relates to the filing today by the Small Business Advocate of a Notice of Intervention in the above-captioned proceeding. PPL Electric Utilities Corporation ("PPL" or the "Company") initiated the proceeding by filing its Petition for Approval to Implement a Reconciliation Rider for Default Supply Service on August 3, 2011.

The Small Business Advocate files this Notice of Intervention in order to protect the interests of the Company's small business customers. A reconciliation rider could affect the rates paid by the Company's small business customers. Moreover, the OSBA seeks to ensure that the Petition does not affect and is without prejudice to the pending Commission proceedings

regarding PPL's current reconciliation mechanisms, the Transmission Service Charge ("TSC") and Generation Supply Charge-1 ("GSC-1"), in which the OSBA is a party.

In view of the foregoing, the Small Business Advocate will participate in this proceeding to investigate the reasonableness and lawfulness of the proposed reconciliation rider.
