- **Reports of Gross Receipts:** Applicant shall report its Pennsylvania intrastate gross receipts to the Commission on a quarterly and year to date basis no later than 30 days following the end of the quarter.
- **The Treasurer or other appropriate officer of Applicant shall transmit to the Department of Revenue by March 15, an annual report, and under oath or affirmation, of the amount of gross receipts received by Applicant during the prior calendar year.**
- **Applicant shall report to the Commission the percentages of total electricity supplied by each fuel source on an annual basis:**

- Applicant will be required to meet periodic reporting requirements as may be issued by the Commission to fulfill the Commission's duty under Chapter 28 pertaining to reliability and to inform the Governor and Legislature of the progress of the transition to a fully competitive electric market.

- d. **TRANSFER OF LICENSE:** The Applicant understands that if it plans to transfer its license to another entity, it is required to request authority from the Commission for permission prior to transferring the license. See 66 Pa. C.S. Section 2809(D). Transferee will be required to file the appropriate licensing application.

- e. **ASSESSMENT:** The Commission does not presently assess Electric Generation Suppliers for the purposes of recovery of regulatory expenses; see *PPL Energyplus, LLC v. Commonwealth*, 800 A.2d 360 (Pa. Cmwlth. 2002).





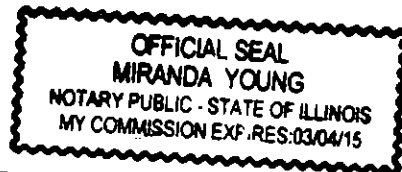

ORDER

By the Commission:

I. PRELIMINARY MATTERS

On September 8, 2008, Nordic Energy Services, LLC ("Applicant" or "Nordic Energy") filed a verified application with the Illinois Commerce Commission ("Commission") requesting a certificate of service authority in order to become an alternative retail electric supplier ("ARES") in Illinois pursuant to Section 16-115 of the Public Utilities Act ("Act"), 220 ILCS 5/1-101 et seq., and 83 Ill. Adm. Code 451 ("Part 451"). Applicant submitted its certificate of publication showing that on September 11, 2008, proper notice of the application was published in the official state newspaper. On September 17, 2008, the Administrative Law Judge requested clarification of certain matters contained in the application. Applicant filed a verified response to the Administrative Law Judge on September 24, 2008.

II. BACKGROUND AND AUTHORITY SOUGHT BY APPLICANT

In this proceeding, Applicant seeks a certificate of service authority to allow it to sell electricity and power to all eligible nonresidential customers with annual electrical consumption greater than 15,000 kilowatt-hours ("kWh") in the service area of Commonwealth Edison Company.

III. REQUIREMENTS FOR ALL APPLICANTS UNDER SECTION 16-115(d) OF THE ACT

Applicant is a limited liability company organized under the laws of Illinois. Applicant does not intend to install, operate, or maintain generation, transmission, or distribution facilities within the State of Illinois. Therefore, no demonstration of compliance with the requirements of Section 451.20(f)(2) has been made and Applicant's employees are not permitted to perform such functions, and other entities are not permitted to perform such functions pursuant to contractual arrangements with Applicant.

Applicant claims it is an independently owned Chicago based energy management firm specializing in managing clients' natural gas and electric requirements. Nordic says its customers enjoy a focused approach to energy procurement, contract negotiations, customized risk management, and effective energy operation cost reduction strategies. Applicant states that it is authorized and licensed to supply natural gas to commercial and residential customers in Illinois and Indiana. Applicant says it will be offering standard industry retail electric products which may include, among others, fixed rate, block-index, and variable rate offers.

Applicant has certified that it will comply with all applicable regulations; that it will provide service only to retail customers eligible to take such services; that it will comply with informational and reporting requirements established by Commission rule; that it will comply with informational and reporting requirements pursuant to Section 16-112 of the Act; and that it will comply with all other applicable laws, regulations, terms, and conditions required to the extent they have application to the services being offered by an ARES. Additionally, Applicant has agreed to submit good faith schedules of transmission and energy in accordance with applicable tariffs. Applicant has agreed to adopt and follow rules relating to customer authorizations, billing records, and retail electric services and agrees to retain requests for delivery services transmitted to utilities for a period of not less than two calendar years after the calendar year in which they are created. Applicant has agreed to adopt and follow rules and procedures to preserve the confidentiality of its customers' data.

Pursuant to the requirements of Section 451.50 of Part 451, Applicant provided a License or Permit Bond in the amount of \$150,000 issued by a qualifying surety authorized to transact business in Illinois. Attachment C to the application is a copy of the required License or Permit Bond.

IV. FINANCIAL, TECHNICAL, AND MANAGERIAL REQUIREMENTS OF SECTION 16-115

Applicant asserts that it meets the financial qualifications set forth in Section 16-115(d)(1). In its application, for purposes of compliance with the provisions of Section 451.320(a)(4), Applicant provided a Letter of Credit in an amount that was calculated pursuant to the formula set forth in Section 451.220(a)(4) using the market value of power and energy established by the Commission. The Payment Bond, Attachment D, to the application, is valid for a period of one year and Applicant provided the additional information required by Section 451.220(a)(4)(C).

Applicant represents that it meets the technical and managerial qualifications set forth in Section 16-115(d)(1) and Sections 451.330 and 451.340. Applicant identified the personnel who purportedly satisfy the criteria and provided biographical information for these individuals. Applicant indicates that it has arrangements in place to provide a 24-hour manned energy desk for coordination with control centers of scheduling changes, reserve implementation, curtailment orders, and interruption plan implementation. Applicant provided a telephone number, facsimile number and

address where its staff can be directly reached at all times. Having reviewed the information submitted by Applicant, the Commission concludes that Applicant meets the financial, technical, and managerial qualifications set forth in Section 16-115(d)(1) of the Act and Subpart D of Part 451.

V. COMMISSION CONCLUSION AND CERTIFICATE OF SERVICE AUTHORITY

The Commission has reviewed the application and attachments along with the supplementary information provided by Applicant regarding the technical, financial, and managerial requirements and all other requirements of the Act and Part 451 and finds that the Applicant sufficiently demonstrates compliance with the requirements.

The Commission concludes, therefore, that the application for a certificate of service authority to operate as an ARES should be granted and that the certificate should read as follows:

CERTIFICATE OF SERVICE AUTHORITY

IT IS CERTIFIED that Nordic Energy Services, LLC is granted service authority to operate as an Alternative Retail Electric Supplier as follows:

SERVICES TO BE PROVIDED: The sale of electricity and power.

CUSTOMERS TO BE SERVED: All eligible nonresidential retail customers with annual electrical consumption greater than 15,000 kWh.

GEOGRAPHIC REGION(S) SERVED: The service area of Commonwealth Edison Company.

VI. FINDINGS AND ORDERING PARAGRAPHS

The Commission, having reviewed the entire record, is of the opinion and finds that:

- (1) Applicant, Nordic Energy Services, LLC, a business organized under the laws of, and authorized to do business in Illinois, seeks a certificate of service authority to operate as an Alternative Retail Electric Supplier under Section 16-115 of the Act;
- (2) the Commission has jurisdiction over the parties hereto and the subject matter hereof;
- (3) the recitals of fact and conclusions reached in the prefatory portion of this Order are supported by the record and are hereby adopted as findings of fact, as required by Section 16-115(d)(1) of the Act;

- (4) Applicant has demonstrated that it possesses sufficient technical, financial, and managerial resources and abilities to provide power and energy to eligible nonresidential retail customers with annual electrical consumption greater than 15,000 kWh throughout the areas certified herein;
- (5) Applicant has complied with Section 16-115(d)(1) through (4), (6) and (8) of the Act and 83 Ill. Adm. Code 451; and
- (6) Nordic Energy Services, LLC should be granted a certificate of service authority to operate as an alternative retail electric supplier in those service areas identified in Section V of this Order.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Illinois Commerce Commission that Nordic Energy Services, LLC is hereby granted the Certificate of Service Authority set out in Section V of this Order, subject to the conditions contained in this Order.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Nordic Energy Services, LLC shall comply with all applicable Commission rules and orders now and as hereafter amended.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that, subject to the provisions of Section 10-113 of the Public Utilities Act and 83 Ill. Adm. Code 200.880, this Order is final; it is not subject to the Administrative Review Law.

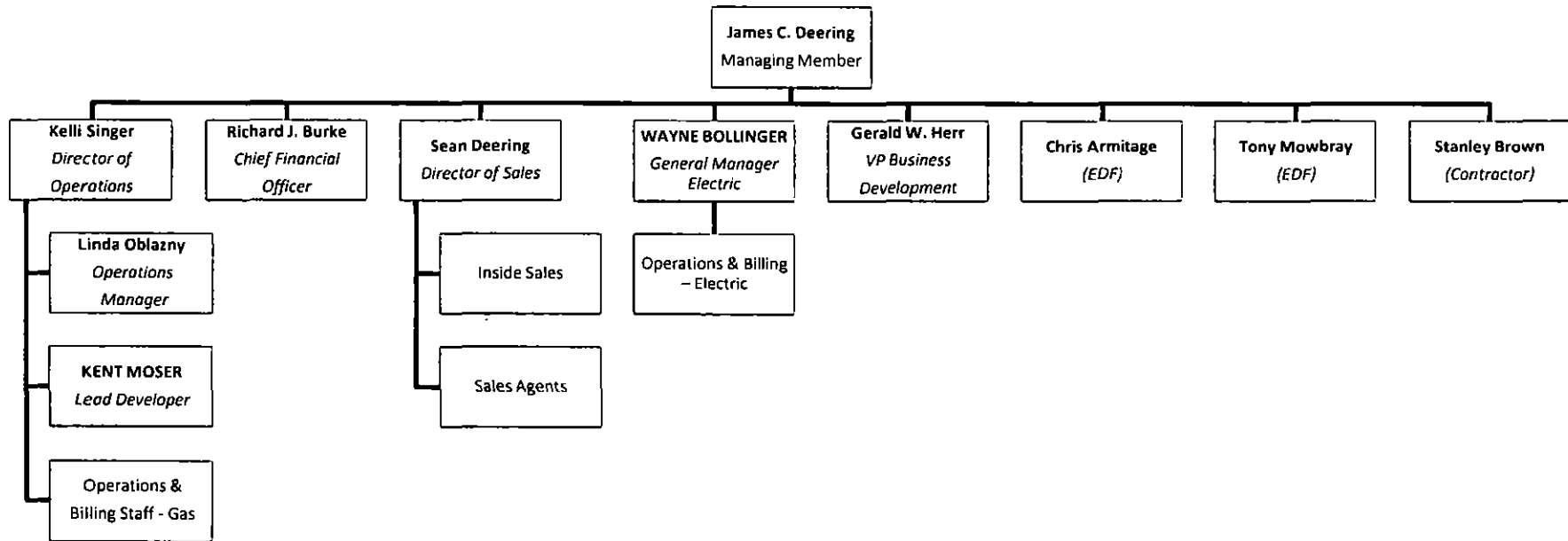

8. MEMBERS COMMITTEE, 8.1 Sectors., 8.1.1 Designation.

Voting on the Senior Standing Committees shall be by sectors. The Senior Standing Committee shall be composed of five sectors, one for Generation Owners, one for Other Suppliers, one for Transmission Owners, one for Electric Distributors, and one for End-Use Customers, provided that there are at least five Members in each Sector. Purchase of Electricity Supply Service. This is an agreement for electric generation service, between Nordic Energy Services, LLC (“Nordic Energy” also referred to as “we” and “our”) and Customer NAME and ADDRESS, who shall be referred to as “you” or “your” in this agreement. Nordic Energy agrees to sell, and you agree to buy, your full requirements for residential electricity generation service at the price and on the terms and conditions specified in this agreement (the “Contract”).

Background

Nordic Energy is licensed by the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission to offer and supply electric generation services in Pennsylvania. Our PUC license number is A-XXXX-XXXXXXX. Should the EDC cease providing consolidated billing for your account and/or commence billing us for any charges relating to you, we will bill you and you will pay us for all such charges. We reserve the right to change our billing methods. If we change our billing methods, we will send you two (2) advance written notices either in your bills or in separate mailings between 45 and 90 days before the effective date of the changes.

Right of Rescission. You may cancel this Contract at any time before midnight of the third business day after receiving this disclosure by either notifying us in writing at the address provided below or by phone by calling us at _____ that you would like to rescind this Contract before we notify the EDC of our enrollment as your electric power supplier.

Price to Compare. Please note that our fixed price is lower than the EDC’s price to compare as of the date of this offer. However, while we offer a fixed price, the EDC’s price to compare likely will change from time to time and therefor Nordic Energy cannot guarantee savings over the EDC’s rates for the entire term of this Contract or any renewals.

Definitions

“Generation Charge” means charges for production of electricity.

“Transmission Charge” means charges for moving high voltage electricity from a generation facility to the EDC’s distribution lines.

Basic Service Price. You will buy your electricity generation service for the account(s) associated with the above street address from Nordic Energy beginning on a date set by your EDC and continuing for an initial term of SELECT twelve (12) or SELECT twenty-four (24) months (as selected by your). After the initial term, this Contract may be renewed for an additional time period in accordance with the renewal section below or until cancelled in writing by Nordic Energy or you as provided in the "**Cancellation**" section below.

Penalties, Fees and Exceptions. In addition to amounts owed for your electricity generation service:

(a) If Nordic Energy directly invoices you, you are required to pay our invoices within 20 days from the invoice date and we reserve the right to charge you interest for any past due invoice amount at 1.5% per month or the highest amount permissible under applicable law, whichever is less. In addition, you agree to pay Nordic Energy's costs incurred in collecting amounts owed us, including reasonable attorney's fees and returned check charges. If you make a payment for any amount less than the total amount due, we may accept such payment without prejudice to any other rights or remedies that we may have against you and we may apply it to your account(s) as a partial payment.

(b) If you cancel this Contract, you may be responsible for payment of an early cancellation fee of \$150.00 as provided in the "**Cancellation**" section below.

Cancellation. (a) Nordic Energy may cancel this Contract for any non-payment or any other breach of this Contract upon 30-days prior written notice to you of such cancellation. If you fail to cure within the 30-day notice period, we may cancel the Contract even if you subsequently cure the non-payment or breach after such period has expired. We may also cancel this Contract upon 30 days' prior written notice to you if you are no longer eligible for consolidated billing by the EDC or if, due to a change in law or other act beyond our reasonable control, we are no longer able to serve you. Either you or Nordic Energy may cancel this Contract during a month-to-month renewal period upon written notice in accordance with the renewal provision below effective as of the end of the next applicable meter read date after the expiration of the required notice period.

You may also cancel this Contract prior to the end of the applicable term for your convenience by giving us not less than 30 days prior written notice, in which case you will be charged a cancellation fee of \$150.00.

Upon any cancellation of this Contract, you will return to receiving default service from the EDC unless you have selected another electric power supplier. The effective date of any cancellation will be the next applicable meter read date after expiration of the required notice period. Upon any cancellation, you will remain responsible for any unpaid balance as of the cancellation date plus any applicable cancellation fee. The delivery of electricity to you cannot be terminated or interrupted by the EDC as a result of any dispute between Nordic Energy and you but may be terminated by the EDC for nonpayment of EDC charges in accordance with applicable law. If the EDC purchases the right to receive your payments under this Contract, your payment obligations may become EDC charges for purposes of termination of service.

(b) If you move, our Contract will end and you will be required to return to EDC service for at least one month for service at your new address after which period we would welcome the opportunity to serve you under a new Contract at your new address. You will be responsible for paying all electricity supplied to your old address until the date this contract is cancelled in accordance with its terms.

(c) Notwithstanding any other provision in this Contract, this Contract may be changed by Nordic Energy upon the occurrence of any event beyond its reasonable control that increases the obligations of Nordic Energy or the cost of performing such obligations under this Contract. If we request such a change, we will provide you notice of the changed prices and/or terms and conditions and you will have an opportunity to cancel this Contract without any further obligation by notifying us in writing within 30 days after receiving notice of the new prices and/or terms and conditions, in which case your electric generation service will be cancelled effective as of a date set by your EDC, after expiration of the required notice period. You will remain responsible for any unpaid balance as of the cancellation date but we will not assess a cancellation payment.

Credit. If you are not enrolled in a Purchase of Receivables program through your EDC, Nordic Energy reserves the right to determine if your credit standing is satisfactory for originating or continuing electric generation service under this Contract. Consistent with applicable law, Nordic Energy uses uniform income, deposit and credit requirements in determining whether to offer service to potential customers.

Renewal Provision/Agreement Expiration/Change in Terms. If you have a fixed term agreement and it is approaching the expiration date or if we propose to change our terms of service, we will send you two (2) advance written notices either in your bills or in separate mailings between 45 and 90 days before either of the expiration date or the effective date of the changes. We will explain your options in these two (2) advance notices.

Limitation of Liability. YOU AGREE THAT NEITHER NORDIC ENERGY NOR ANY OF ITS AFFILIATES OR SUBCONTRACTORS SHALL BE LIABLE FOR ANY DAMAGES OR CLAIMS FOR MATTERS WITHIN THE CONTROL OF THE EDC OR THE ISO-CONTROLLED ELECTRICITY GRID, WHICH INCLUDE MAINTENANCE OF ELECTRIC LINES AND SYSTEMS, SERVICE INTERRUPTIONS, LOSS OR TERMINATION OF SERVICE, DETERIORATION OF ELECTRIC SERVICES, METER READINGS OR INJURY TO PERSONS OR DAMAGE TO PROPERTY CAUSED BY THE DELIVERY OR SUPPLY OF ELECTRICITY, NEITHER NORDIC ENERGY NOR ANY OF ITS AFFILIATES OR SUBCONTRACTORS WILL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR ANY FAILURE TO COMMENCE OR CANCEL ELECTRIC GENERATION SERVICE ON THE DATE SPECIFIED HEREIN DUE TO ANY FAILURE OR DELAY IN ENROLLING YOU WITH THE EDC. NORDIC'S LIABILITY SHALL BE LIMITED TO DIRECT ACTUAL DAMAGES ONLY, WHICH WILL NOT EXCEED THE AMOUNT OF YOUR SINGLE LARGEST MONTHLY INVOICE DURING THE PRECEDING 12 MONTHS. IN NO EVENT SHALL NORDIC ENERGY OR ANY OF ITS AFFILIATES OR SUBCONTRACTORS BE LIABLE FOR ANY PUNITIVE, INCIDENTAL, CONSEQUENTIAL, EXEMPLARY, INDIRECT, THIRD-PARTY CLAIMS OR OTHER DAMAGES WHETHER BASED ON CONTRACT, WARRANTY, TORT, NEGLIGENCE, STRICT LIABILITY OR OTHERWISE, OR FOR LOST PROFITS ARISING FROM ANY BREACH OR NONPERFORMANCE OF THIS CONTRACT.

Force Majeure. We do not transmit or deliver electricity and certain causes and events out of our control ("Force Majeure Events") may result in interruptions in service. We will not be liable for any such interruptions or any other failure to perform under this Contract caused by a Force Majeure Event. We are not and will not be liable for damages caused by Force Majeure Events, including acts of God; acts of any governmental authority; accidents; strikes; labor disputes; required maintenance work; inability to access the EDC's system; non-performance by the EDC, including, but not limited to, a facility outage on its distribution lines; changes in laws, rules or regulations of any governmental authority; or any cause beyond our control.

Miscellaneous. Except with respect to Nordic Energy's affiliates and subcontractors under the "Limitation of Liability" section, there are no third party beneficiaries of this contract. Any payments due under this Contract, and all provisions relating to the payment and collection thereof, shall survive cancellation for any reason. This Contract constitutes the entire agreement between you and Nordic Energy. No statement, promise or inducement made by either party not contained in this Contract shall be valid or binding. Any reference to days or periods shall mean calendar days.

Assignment, Address Change. Nordic Energy may in accordance with applicable law, assign, subcontract or delegate all or any part of our rights and/or obligations under this Contract, including your payment obligations under this Contract. You may not assign any of your rights or obligation under this Contract without our prior written consent. If you move, our Contract will be cancelled and you will be required to return to EDC

service for at least one month for service at your new address after which period we would welcome the opportunity to serve you under a new Contract at your new address. You will be responsible for paying all electricity supplied to your old address until the date this Contract is cancelled in accordance with its terms.

In accordance with section 8.1.1 of the PJM Operating Agreement, Members are permitted to change their sector by providing written notice to PJM no later than ten (10) days prior to the Annual Meeting of the Members. The last day the sector changes will be accepted is Monday, May 9, 2011.

8. MEMBERS COMMITTEE, 8.1 Sectors., 8.1.1 Designation.

Voting on the Senior Standing Committees shall be by sectors. The Senior Standing Committee shall be composed of five sectors, one for Generation Owners, one for Other Suppliers, one for Transmission Owners, one for Electric Distributors, and one for End-Use Customers, provided that there are at least five Members in each Sector. Except as specified in Section 8.1.2, each Voting Member shall have one vote. Each Voting Member shall, within thirty (30) days after the Effective Date or, if later, thirty (30) days after becoming a Member, and thereafter not later than 10 days prior to the Annual Meeting of the Members for each annual period beginning with the Annual Meeting of the Members, submit to the President a sealed notice of the sector in which it is qualified to vote or, if qualified to participate in more than one sector, its rank order preference of the sectors in which it wishes to vote, and shall be assigned to its highest-ranked sector that has the minimum number of Members specified above. If a Member is assigned to a sector other than its highest-ranked sector in accordance with the preceding sentence, its higher sector preference or preferences shall be honored as soon as a higher-ranked sector has five or more Members. A Voting Member may designate as its voting sector any sector for which it or its Affiliate or Related Party Members is qualified. The sector designations of the Voting Members shall be announced by the Office of the Interconnection at the Annual Meeting and shall apply to all Senior Standing Committees.
