

I am writing this letter to ask for a continuance. I currently have a pending court date of September 7, 2011 at 9:00 a.m.

At this time I am eight months pregnant, and I am considered high risk, due to preterm laboring. I have been put on strict bed rest. On the date of the hearing I will be 36 weeks gestation. 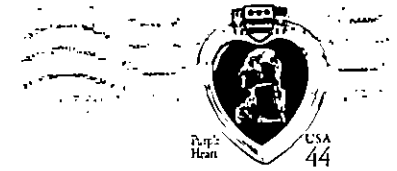
