(a) Complainants, David Stengel and Frederic Schneider, and Respondent, PPL, agree that PPL will apply a credit to Complainants' account in the amount of \$653.60, which will result in a balance on the account in the amount of \$2,267.89. The parties further agree that Complainants will pay their monthly bills plus \$48 per month towards arrearages, until all arrearages are paid in full.

(b) Complainants withdraw their Complaint.

5. 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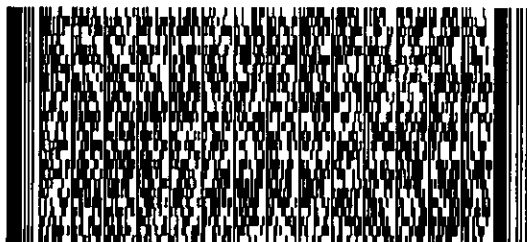
