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

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**MOTION TO STRIKE, DISMISS, OR MARK
COMPLAINT PROCEEDING CLOSED**

TO: Administrative Law Judge Katrina L. Dunderdale:

NOW COMES Total Environmental Solutions, Inc. ("TESI"), by its attorneys, Hawke McKeon & Sniscak LLP, and moves pursuant to 52 Pa. Code §5.103 as follows:

1. Complainant is an availability customer of TESI.
2. On August 12, 2010 the Public Utility Commission's ("Commission") Secretary's Bureau docketed the above-referenced Complaint, which listed no utility respondent, but in paragraph 3 Complainant indicated it was pertaining to a water utility and in paragraph 4 indicated it wanted to oppose the company's proposed rate increase (docketed at R-2010-2171918) and did not want to pay availability charges.
3. The above-captioned Complaint was not received by TESI, nor served upon its counsel in the rate proceeding as were other complaints against the increase. Instead, only the first page of instructions from the Secretary was received at TESI's Baton Rouge, Louisiana office.
4. At or about the same time a virtually identical complaint was received from the same complainant and given a different docket number, C-2010-2193282. The only difference between the C-2010-2193282 complaint and the above-captioned complaint was the former specified as the

name of the utility company respondent “Total Environmental Solutions Inc. [sic]” whereas the C-2010-2193690 had no name or left blank the name of utility of which it complained. The rate case to which the complaints pertained was subject to a settlement which the Commission approved, by Order entered March 17, 2011, and it dismissed or denied all complaints against the rate case. On October 4, 2010, the Presiding Officer, by letter dated October 4, 2010, advised the parties that Mr. Valenzisi had withdrawn his complaint. Copies of the referenced complaints and pertinent part of the Commission’s Order are attached as **Appendix “1.”**

5. By First Interim Order at Docket No. C-2010-2193690 issued September 9, 2011, TESI was directed by the Presiding Officer in said rate case to file an Answer by Wednesday, September 21, 2011 to the above-referenced complaint, or that in the absence of an answer a judgment may be entered against TESI without further notice.

6. The Commission’s regulations generally provide that no answers are required to complaints regarding rate case issues in general rate case proceedings. 52 Pa. Code §5.61(d). Moreover, the rate case proceedings for TESI have concluded so an Answer would be pointless, and the Complainant has withdrawn the very same grounds alleged.

7. A telephone hearing has been scheduled in this matter for Wednesday, October 26, 2011.

8. TESI suspects that the two virtually identical complaints, both of which are indicated as against the water utility and its rate increase, but one of which did not, in paragraph 2, include the name of the company, while the other one filed at or about the same time did, indicates either that they are the same complaint making the same allegations about the same matter, or that one was filed to correct the omission of the name of the utility in paragraph 2. In either event, the above-captioned duplicate complaint should be stricken, dismissed or marked as closed given that the

issues raised in the virtually identical complaints were resolved by the Commission and one of virtually identical complaints was withdrawn by the Complainant.

9. To proceed further with this, which was compounded by giving essentially the same complaint two dockets, would be a tremendous waste of time and resources for the Commission and the parties. Accordingly, the Complaint should be stricken as duplicative, and therefore legally insufficient, marked closed as the very same allegations were withdrawn, and dismissed or marked closed as the Commission has already concluded the rate proceeding including dismissing or denying all complaints.

WHEREFORE, for the foregoing reasons, Total Environmental Solutions, Inc. respectfully requests (1) any Answer or hearing be postponed pending consideration of this motion, and (2) that the relief requested in this motion be granted.

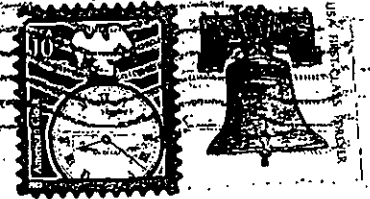

OPINION AND ORDER

BY THE COMMISSION

Before the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission (Commission) for consideration and disposition are the Exceptions filed by Total Environmental Solutions, Inc. (TESI or Company) filed on January 20, 2011, to the Recommended Decision (R.D.) of Administrative Law Judge Katrina L. Dunderdale (ALJ), issued on January 10, 2011. No Reply Exceptions were filed. Also before the Commission are the Joint Petitions for Settlement of Rate Investigation (Settlements)¹ filed on November 30, 2010.

I. Background

TESI provides both water and wastewater service to approximately 2,105 residential and commercial customers and to 3,455 availability customers in portions of Sandy Township, Clearfield County, Pennsylvania. On June 30, 2010, TESI filed proposed tariffs that were calculated to produce a \$376,183, or a 62.2% increase in annual water service revenue and a \$268,150, or a 25.6% increase in annual wastewater revenue.

¹ Individual Settlements were filed for the water and wastewater tariff filings.

7. That Total Environmental Solutions, Inc. – Treasure Lake Wastewater Division is hereby authorized to file tariffs, tariff supplements, or tariff revisions containing rates, rules and regulations, consistent with the Joint Petition for Settlement of Rate Investigation filed by Total Environmental Solutions, Inc., the Office of Trial Staff, and the Office of Consumer Advocate, to produce an increase in total annual operating revenues of \$105,059, not to exceed a total annual operating revenue of \$1,153,842.

8. That Total Environmental Solutions, Inc. – Treasure Lake Wastewater Division shall file detailed calculations with its tariff filings, which shall demonstrate to this Commission's satisfaction that the filed rates comply with the proof of revenue, in the form and manner customarily filed in support of compliance tariffs.

9. That Total Environmental Solutions, Inc. – Treasure Lake Wastewater Division's tariffs, tariff supplements, or tariff revisions may be filed upon less than statutory notice and, pursuant to the provisions of 52 Pa. Code §§ 53.31 and 53.101, may be filed to be effective for service rendered on and after the date of entry of this Opinion and Order.

10. That the Complaints filed by the Office of Consumer Advocate, docketed at C-2010-2191449 and C-2010-2191421 are sustained to the extent consistent with this Opinion and Order, and otherwise, are denied and dismissed.
