Dear Judge Colwell:

On August 22, 2011, PPL Electric Utilities Corporation (“PPL Electric” or the “Company”) filed with the Public Utility Commission (“PUC”) the calculation of its Generation Supply Charge-1 (“GSC-1”) for the Application Period September 1, 2011 through November 30, 2011 (“August 22 Filing”).

On August 25, 2011, the Office of Consumer Advocate (“OCA”) filed the above-referenced Complaint at Docket No. C-2011-2259375 against the August 22 Filing. The OCA’s Complaint was primarily directed toward the Time-of-Use (“TOU”) provisions of the August 22 Filing.

In addition, on August 25, 2011, the Office of Small Business Advocate (“OSBA”) filed a Complaint against the August 22 Filing. The OSBA had also filed a Complaint against the Company’s GSC-1 for the June 1, 2011 through August 31, 2011 Application Period, which was docketed at C-2011-2245906. The parties in that proceeding participated in evidentiary hearings before Your Honor and are currently preparing briefs.


Given the similarity between the OCA and OSBA Complaints against the August 22 Filing with other proceedings, PPL Electric, OCA, OSBA and the Commission’s Bureau of Investigation and Enforcement (“I&E”) held a telephone conference call on October 11, 2011 to discuss how to recommend proceeding with litigation of the Complaints against the August 22 Filing. At that

telephone conference, the OCA indicated that it would withdraw its Complaint at Docket No. C-2011-2259375 and will address its issues regarding the Company's TOU filing at Docket No. R-2011-2264771. On October 18, 2011, the OCA filed a Petition for Leave to Withdraw Complaint at Docket No. C-2011-2259375. Also on October 18, 2011, the OCA and OSBA filed Complaints in the Company's TOU filing at Docket No. R-2011-2264771. In addition, PPL Electric, OSBA and I&E agreed to and hereby request that the OSBA Complaint at Docket No. C-2011-2260010 be held in abeyance pending the outcome of the OSBA Complaint at Docket No. C-2011-2245906. The parties believe that this proposed approach will promote judicial efficiency because both OSBA Complaint proceedings involve similar issues.


