Dear Secretary Chiavetta: I have reviewed West Penn Power Company's request for the following:

I have reviewed West Penn Power Company's request for the following:

• postpone the hearing scheduled for October 26, 2011, at 10 AM in the matter of L. Richard Adamovich, Docket No. C-2011-2256848

- consolidate the Complaints of L. Richard Adamovich, Docket No. C-2011-2256848 and of Michael T. Salanick, Docket No. C-2011-2247926 and
- schedule a combined hearing at a time and place as appropriate

Last week, I requested to postpone the hearing for a personal reason. That request is enclosed for your information. Therefore, I agree with West Penn Power Company's request to postpone the hearing.

However, I do not agree with West Penn Power Company's request to consolidate the complaints and schedule a combined hearing as indicated above. I do not have knowledge of Michael T. Salanick's complaint and while West Penn Power Company indicates that it is similar to my complaint, I do not know that. Furthermore, until four days ago, I had no knowledge of the Salanick complaint. Therefore, with no knowledge of the Salanick complaint, no knowledge that the complaint is similar in nature and no knowledge of communication between West Penn Power Company and Mr. Salanick, I request that my complaint stand alone and be heard separate from the Salanick complaint.

As I indicated to Administrative Law Judge Mary D. Long last week, I am retired and with the exception of the October 26, 2011 date, I am available to attend an initial hearing on any date. Similarly, I am available to discuss this matter with you or any member of the Chief Administrative Law Judge's staff at any time.

Please advise me as soon as possible with your decision on my request.
