

Adamo Limousine LTD, (“Adamo”), by and through its undersigned counsel, and pursuant to the provisions of 52 Pa. Code §5.81, hereby requests that the Commission grant this Motion to Consolidate and consolidate the above proceedings for purposes of hearings and adjudication because they raise common issues of fact and law, and therefore promote the prompt, efficient, and consistent administration of justice. In support of this Motion, Adamo states as follows:

1. On or about June 11, 2010, the Bureau of Transportation and Safety initiated a complaint against Adamo for failure to pay its 2009-2010 Annual Assessment of \$8800.00 to the Commission.
2. On or about September 15, 2011, the Bureau of Transportation and Safety initiated a complaint against Adamo for failure to pay its 2010-2011 Annual Assessment in the amount of \$6,304.00 to the Commission.


3. The complaint at C-2010-2180666 has been referred to Administrative Law Judge Salapa for adjudication. Although no assignment has been made with regard to C-2011-2262621, granting of this Motion to Consolidate will result in both proceedings being assigned to ALJ Salapa.

4. Both of the complaints involve the same parties and common issues of law - the assessment of a UCR carrier and the necessity to file objections to assessments.

5. As these cases involve common issues of fact and law, consolidation of these two proceedings will promote the efficient use of time and resources of the parties and the Commission.

6. Counsel for the Commission has been contacted and does not oppose this Motion.
