

CONSENTED TO MOTION FOR CONTINUANCE OF HEARING

Complainant, Robert Wagner, by and through his attorney, Rebecca A. Olds, makes the following request:

1. Robert Wagner retained the services of Rebecca Olds on October 26, 2011.
2. A hearing is scheduled in this matter for November 7, 2011. Ms. Olds has an unemployment compensation hearing which was specially scheduled for November 7th because it is complex matter requiring more than the time usually allotted for that type of hearing. 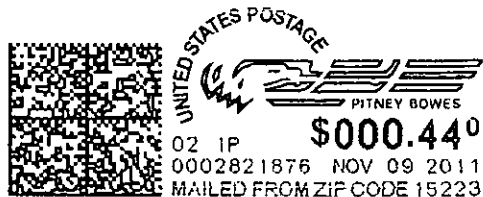
