Dear Ms. Chiavetta:

Enclosed for filing on behalf of PPL Electric Utilities Corporation ("PPL Electric") are an original and three (3) copies of PPL Electric's Request for Exclusion of October 29 – November 5, 2011 Major Outage Data for Reliability Reporting Purposes. This request is being filed pursuant to the Commission's Order, entered May 11, 2004, at Docket No. M-00991220.

This request for exclusion of major outage data relates to the electric service interruptions associated with the early Fall snowstorm which adversely affected PPL Electric's service territory from October 29 through November 5, 2011. Specific impacts of this event are detailed in PPL Electric's Storm Report of Electric Service Interruptions filed on November 14, 2011, pursuant to the Commission's regulations at 52 Pa. Code § 67.1. The requested exclusion applies only to electric service interruptions directly related to the early Fall snowstorm during the specified time period.

Pursuant to 52 Pa. Code §1.11, the enclosed document is to be deemed filed on November 17, 2011, which is the date it was deposited with an overnight express delivery service as shown on the delivery receipt attached to the mailing envelope.

  - (c) Reason for interruption or outage, including weather data where applicable:  
During the morning of Saturday, October 29, 2011, PPL Electric Utilities Corporation's ("PPL Electric") 29-county service area began to feel the effects of an unusual Fall nor'easter. Heavy, wet snow began falling on Saturday, October 29, 2011, and continued until the early evening. Snowfall of up to 13 inches was reported by the National Weather Service. The heavy, wet snow accumulated on trees and their leaves, resulting in significant vegetation damage. Large trees and branches from outside PPL Electric's rights-of-way made contact with transmission and distribution facilities resulting in many downed conductors. Restoration efforts were often hampered by the need for tree removal.

Remarks:

There were 157 permanent 12kV circuit breaker interruptions which resulted in 229,265 customer service interruptions of which 80,005 were transmission-related.

A total of 3,170 people worked in various capacities to support the storm restoration effort. Including:

- 791 PPL Electric physical workers.
- 1,610 electrical contractors, external utilities, contract assessors and tree contractors supported the restoration effort. Support represented six states.
- 778 internal PPL Electric support personnel.

To help keep customers informed, PPL Electric conducted outreach call campaigns from October 30, 2011 through November 2, 2011.

PPL Electric successfully received 433,826 phone calls between 8:00 AM on October 29, 2011, and 10:00 PM on November 4, 2011

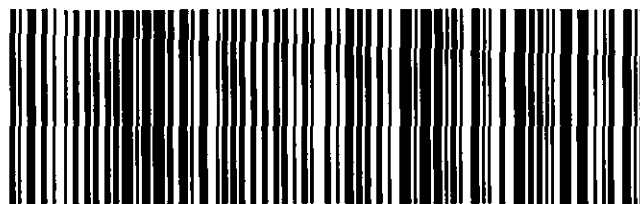
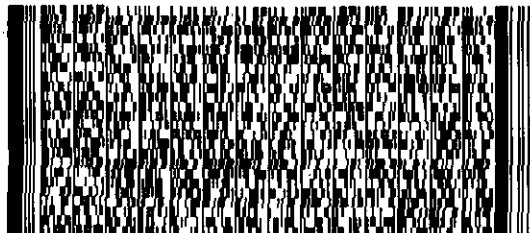

Your right to recover from FedEx for any loss, including intrinsic value of the package, loss of sales, income interest, profit, attorney's fees, costs, and other forms of damage whether direct, incidental, consequential, or special is limited to the greater of \$100 or the authorized declared value. Recovery cannot exceed actual documented loss. Maximum for items of extraordinary value is \$500, e.g. jewelry, precious metals, negotiable instruments and other items listed in our ServiceGuide. Written claims must be filed within strict time limits, see current FedEx Service Guide.
