

PETITION FOR ISSUANCE OF A SUBPOENA

TO THE HONORABLE John Corbett:

The Law Bureau, representing the Bureau of Transportation and Safety of the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission, by its counsel, John Herzog, petitions for issuance of a subpoena and in support thereof represents as follows:

1. The name and address of your petitioner the Bureau of Transportation and Safety of the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission, P.O. Box 3265, Harrisburg, Pennsylvania 17105-3265.
2. The name and address of the attorney for the petitioner is Assistant Counsel John Herzog, Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission, P.O. Box 3265, Harrisburg, PA 17105-3265.
3. A hearing will be held by the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission before Administrative Law Judge John Corbett at 10:00 a.m. on Wednesday, September 14, 2011, in an available Hearing Room on the second floor of Piatt Place, 301 Fifth Avenue, Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania.
4. The purpose of the hearing is to afford all parties of record the opportunity to submit testimony in the above-captioned proceeding.
5. The Complaint in this matter alleged that Respondent violated 66 Pa.C.S. §1501 by failing to render reasonable service, and 52 Pa. Code §29.101 by failing to be in direct control

and supervision of its service. The person involved in the dispute is Granger Morgan, as detailed in the complaint.

6. Granger Morgan is in a position to testify to the issue of whether Respondent violated the Public Utility Code and the Commission's regulations.

WHEREFORE, the Law Bureau requests that your Honorable Administrative Law Judge, grant its PETITION FOR ISSUANCE OF A SUBPOENA, and issue a subpoena compelling the appearance of Granger Morgan.


