



**CONSENTED TO MOTION FOR CONTINUANCE OF HEARING**

Complainant, Robert Wagner, by and through his attorney, Rebecca A. Olds, makes the following request:

1. Robert Wagner retained the services of Rebecca Olds on October 26, 2011.
2. A hearing is scheduled in this matter for November 7, 2011. Ms. Olds has an unemployment compensation hearing which was specially scheduled for November 7<sup>th</sup> because it is complex matter requiring more than the time usually allotted for that type of hearing. The unemployment compensation hearing cannot be rescheduled.
3. This case presents an important question of the reasonableness of the utility service provided by Duquesne Light. It involves difficult issues, and counsel will require time to investigate facts and research legal issues.




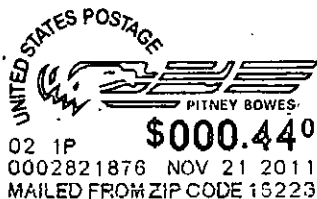
