**Petition to Withdraw Complaint/Appeal**

**And Now** comes Respondent - Appellant, Columbia Gas of Pennsylvania, Inc. (Columbia Gas), pursuant to *52 Pa. Code*, Section 5.94, and states and avers as follows:


1. On July 5, 2007, Columbia Gas filed a Complaint/Appeal from a decision rendered by the Bureau of Consumer Services (BCS) on June 13, 2011 at BCS Case No. 2843166.
2. The BCS decision issued a Section 1407 C 2 iii decision providing for the restoration of service upon the payment of \$30.00, thereafter the Customer to pay each month the current budget amount of \$132.00 and the additional sum of \$30.00 toward Complainant's arrearage, for a total payment of \$162.00 per month for 24 months.<sup>1</sup>
3. In accordance with the BCS decision, Complainant's service was reconnected on June 17, 2011 after receipt of the required \$30.00 payment. However, Complainant made no further payments on the account and requested that the account be disconnected on September 8, 2011. Complainant is no longer a customer of Columbia Gas. Consequently, there no longer exists any justiciable issue that Columbia Gas desires to contest. Therefore, no case or controversy exists, and the Complaint/Appeal filed by Columbia Gas is moot.

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<sup>1</sup> The BCS decision incorrectly states; "... this is a CO agreement." Columbia Gas did not offer Complainant a Section 1407 C 2 iii payment plan. Apparently Complainant called the BCS and requested a Section 1407 C 2 iii payment plan. To the contrary, Columbia Gas advised Complainant that for restoration of service and reinstatement in the CAP, Complainant was required to pay the \$715.00 CAP catch-up amount. For some inexplicable reason, the BCS attempted to characterize this as a company payment plan.

**Wherefore**, Columbia Gas requests leave to withdraw the Complaint/Appeal filed in this proceeding and requests that the docket be marked closed.


