PETITION FOR ISSUANCE OF SUBPOENAS

And now this 8th day of December 2011 comes the Bureau of Investigation and Enforcement of the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission by its attorney R. K. Smith, Jr., to Petition for the Issuance of Subpoenas and in support thereof represents as follows:

3. A hearing will be held by the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission before Administrative Law Judge John H. Corbett, Jr. at 10:00 a.m., on Wednesday, January 18, 2011, in the 2nd floor hearing room, Piatt Place, Suite 220, 301 Fifth Avenue, Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania 15222.

4. The purpose of the hearing is to afford all parties of record the opportunity to submit testimony in the above captioned proceeding.

5. The captioned complaint alleged that on June 11, 2010, the driver of Yellow Cab of Pittsburgh taxicab number 331 refused to transport the Terry Griffith party from the Pittsburgh International Airport to the Microtel after being advised by Mr. Griffith that the hotel would be paying the taxicab fare rather than the passengers riding in the vehicle. Mr. Greg Sickora, also a member of the Griffith party also heard the driver of Respondent's taxicab number 331 say that he would not transport the group unless the passengers paid the fare.

That Respondent, by failing to transport a group of orderly passengers for lawful purposes, violated 52 Code § 29.313(a). The Bureau requested that Respondent be assessed a cited penalty of \$500.


