**PUBLIC STATEMENT OF
THE OFFICE OF SMALL BUSINESS ADVOCATE**

The Small Business Advocate is authorized and directed to represent the interest of small business consumers of utility services in Pennsylvania under the provisions of the Small Business Advocate Act, Act 181 of 1988, 73 P.S. §§ 399.41 - 399.50 (the "Act"). The Act further provides that the Small Business Advocate is to issue publicly a written statement stating concisely the specific interest of small business consumers to be protected by his initiation of or intervention in any proceeding involving those interests before the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission (the "Commission") or any other agency or court. This public statement relates to the filing today by the Small Business Advocate of a complaint against the proposed Generation Supply Charge-1 ("GSC-1") filed by PPL Electric Utilities Corporation ("PPL Electric" or the "Company") on November 18, 2011.

The Small Business Advocate is filing this formal complaint against the Company's proposed GSC-1 in order to protect the interests of the Company's small business customers. A thorough inquiry by the Commission into all of the elements of the Company's proposal is necessary to ensure that the GSC-1 is lawful, just, reasonable, and not unduly discriminatory.

In calculating its updated GSC-1, the Company is proposing to refund a significant overcollection to PPL's small commercial and industrial customers. While the OSBA agrees that prior period overcollections should be refunded to ratepayers, this over-collection credit follows

large and volatile undercollection charges for the first eleven months of 2011. The Company's GSC-1 rates therefore continue to be unstable, unpredictable, and detrimental to competition.

In view of the foregoing, the Small Business Advocate will participate in proceedings before the Commission to investigate whether the proposed GSC-1 is lawful, just, reasonable, and not unduly discriminatory to the Company's small business customers.
