CONSENTED TO MOTION FOR SECOND CONTINUANCE OF HEARING


Complainant, Robert Wagner, by and through his attorney, Rebecca A. Olds, makes the following request:

1. A hearing was scheduled in this case for November 7, 2011.
2. The undersigned counsel requested a continuance of that hearing which was granted.
3. An Order rescheduling the hearing was issued scheduling the hearing for January 9, 2012. The order rescheduling the hearing was mailed directly to the Complainant. Therefore, undersigned counsel was not served with a copy of the order which was sent to her client. The Complainant apparently did not know counsel was not served, and did not alert her after receiving the order. Counsel was actually not aware that the proceeding was rescheduled for a date certain.
4. Since the undersigned was not aware that the hearing was rescheduled for January 9th, and did not learn of that fact until today when she had a conversation with counsel for the Respondent, she cannot sufficiently prepare for that hearing.

5. A framework for rescheduling this case has been discussed, and would be beneficial to allow the parties to engage in settlement negotiations with the goal of eliminating the necessity for a hearing altogether.
6. Counsel for Duquesne Light, Ms. Krysia Kubiak, did consent to a continuance of the hearing date.

Wherefore, Ms. Olds requests this matter be continued for 45 days for the reasons set forth above.




