Re: Docket # C-2011-2266144 – Further Exhibit Submission – CD Disk #3

Enclosed are 2 data CD's containing further Exhibits for the subject line docket # complaint:

- Exhibit 20: FCC Part 15 and ETSI requirements documentation.
- Exhibit 21: IEEE 519 compliance specifications and regulations – Harmonics and related documentation.
- Exhibit 22: Spectrum analysis measurements taken over a 21 day period utilizing the officially recognized Fast Fourier Transform measurement techniques. Date/time as noted in each sample set.

The extremely large reactance around 60Hz should not be there. It is caused by subharmonic interference. The entire area is experiencing massive jitter as a result.

The massive spectrum disruptions at 50Hz and below should not be there. They are identified as subharmonic and sub-subharmonic hybrid frequencies.

The massive harmonics, interharmonics, and subharmonics in the KHz range should not be there. That they exist and are tangible items is because of BPL/B-PLC equipment generated signal interference and attenuation.

The above listed spectrum disruptions break every rule, regulation, and law that exists and as covered in Exhibit 20 and 21 documentation.

During this time period I contacted WPP customer service several times. I explained to them that these emissions were causing me emotional distress, skin heating and acute stomach pain on a regular basis. I demanded that these facts were entered on my call record. I further explained to them that actual bodily harm, grievous bodily harm, and attempted homicide are criminal offences.

- Exhibit 23: Contact Texts and Power Spectrum Scans. Included in this document are Power Spectrum scans from the USA, UK, Canada, and Australia together with text written by their originator. All of the countries in this sample have BPL/B-PLC installed.
- Exhibit 24: Allentown, PA FCC/ARRL field measurements reports April 28, 2009. The FCC played the entire thing down when stating that emissions were just 3dB over regulatory limits. A 3dB increase/overage is actually a 100% increase in emission power levels.
- Exhibit 25: Letters of complaint from people in the USA affected by BPL/B-PLC emissions. People complain regarding hearing a "hum"; what they do not realize is that their sickness is caused by large microwave emissions that are also present due to BPL/B-PLC.

Exhibit 26: NASA research document – Mechanical Resonant Frequency of the Human Eye In Vivo. Massive 18Hz subharmonic spectrum disruption is present, as shown in Exhibit 22, in the spectrum due to BPL/B-PLC implementation and its associated emissions.

I should invoke my Rights under the Freedom of Information Act Laws and request that West Penn Power (WPP) release to me for analysis all FCC and IEEE regulatory compliance documents applicable to all items of equipment presently installed, or planned for installation, to enable the operation of their BPL and B-PLC efforts. This should include the compliance details of DC power supplies and thyristor circuits utilized in their pole-mounted fast-switching capacitor banks.

Also, invoking the above Rights, I request the initial install emissions/RF transmissions measurement tests documents and emissions/transmission measurement test schedules as are required by law. Both of these items' documentation should include the actual power levels and frequencies utilized by the BPL/B-PLC connectors/injectors to enable BPL/B-PLC over WPP grid infrastructure.

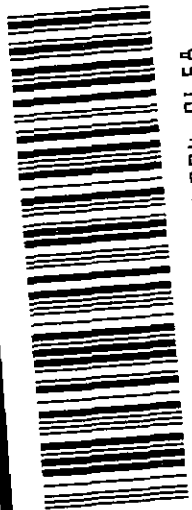
