

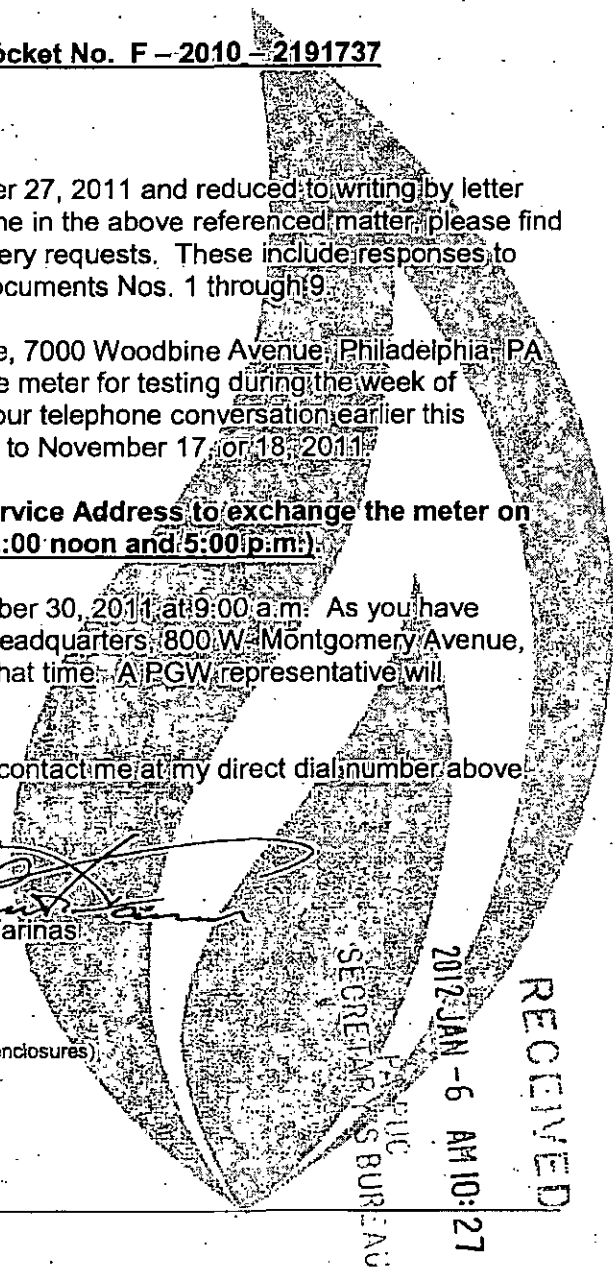

Dear Judge Vero:

After a discussion between PGW and Mrs. Agnes Manu and Mr. Manu, husband (the Complainants), in resolution of the Manu Motion in Limine and PGW's response to it, the parties have agreed to the following:

1. PGW requests (and the Complainants do not object to) a continuance in the hearing of this matter until a hearing date after January 15, 2012, because:
  - (a) PGW needs time to schedule, exchange and test for accuracy the meter at the Manu's residence, 7000 Woodbine Avenue, Philadelphia, PA (Service Address),
  - (b) The Complainants need time review the responses to discovery and the results of the meter test, and;
  - (c) A hearing date after January 15, 2012 will accommodate Mr. Manu's required recuperation after his next medical procedure.
2. PGW will complete the Complainants' discovery requests on or before November 11, 2011.
3. At 3:00 p.m. October 27, 2011, the parties will speak by telephone with possible dates upon which the Complainant's will make the Service Address accessible to PGW to exchange the meter.
4. As the Complainant has designated that the Complainant's PGW bills are inaccurate by approximately 30%, this represents the disputed amount. The Complainants will pay timely, the PGW bill going forward (after the meter exchange) to the extent that these bills are not disputed.

As the Commission has served PGW with a notice that it has changed the hearing scheduled for October 28, 2011 to a Telephonic Prehearing Conference, PGW will participate by telephone and can be reached at 215-284-1105.
