

(a) Complainant and Champion agree that the amount owed by Complainant will be reduced from \$1,101.83 to \$771.69. Complainant and Champion further agree that Complainant will make three equal monthly payments to Champion of \$257.23, and that a monthly payment will be due from Complainant to Champion on or before March 15, 2012, April 16, 2012 and May 15, 2012.

(b) Complainant and Champion further agree that the monthly payments agreed to in Paragraph 4.(a) will be sent to the following address:


