

**PREHEARING CONFERENCE MEMORANDUM OF
PPL ELECTRIC UTILITIES CORPORATION**

TO ADMINISTRATIVE LAW JUDGE EMBER S. JANDEBEUR:

PPL Electric Utilities Corporation (“PPL Electric” or the “Company”), pursuant to 52 Pa. Code § 5.222(d), hereby files this Prehearing Conference Memorandum in the above-captioned matter, and states as follows:

I. PROCEDURAL HISTORY

1. On August 30, 2011, a complaint was filed by Alan and Christine Villano (“Complainants”) at Docket No. C-2011-2259758.
2. On September 19, 2011, PPL Electric filed an Answer to the Complaint.
3. On December 19, 2011, the Commission’s Secretary issued a Hearing Notice in the above-captioned matter. The hearing was scheduled for February 24, 2012, at 10 a.m. before the Honorable Judge Ember S. Jandebaur (the “ALJ”).

4. On January 11, 2012, PPL Electric filed a Request for Relief, wherein the Company requested that the hearing scheduled for February 24, 2012 be converted to a prehearing conference.

5. On February 3, 2012, the ALJ granted PPL Electric's Request for Relief, and converted the hearing to a prehearing conference. The prehearing conference is to be held telephonically and is scheduled for February 24, 2012, at 10 a.m.

PPL Electric agrees to receive service of documents electronically in this proceeding. Further, to the extent that materials are available electronically, it is requested that copies be served upon Paul E. Russell at perussell@pplweb.com, David B. 7. PPL Electric's attorneys are authorized to accept service on behalf of the Company in this proceeding. PPL Electric requests that the Commission and all parties of record serve hard copies of all discovery requests and answers, correspondence, Commission Orders, and any other documents issued in this proceeding on its attorneys in Harrisburg, Pennsylvania.

III. WITNESSES AND ISSUES

8. This prehearing conference was requested by PPL Electric, in part, to determine what issues are going to be addressed in this case. PPL Electric is not certain whether the Complainants intend to call expert witnesses in support of their contentions or which subjects those experts will address. Therefore, PPL Electric is not certain at this time whether it will present expert witnesses in its defense, who those expert witnesses will be or what subjects those witnesses will address. One purpose of the prehearing conference is to address these issues.

9. PPL Electric reserves the right to call witnesses and to present testimony on any issues and subject matters that may arise during the course of the proceeding.

IV. PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

10. This prehearing conference is being held, in part, to determine how the Complainants intend to present their case. Any procedural schedule will have to take into account whether issues will be raised that require PPL Electric to offer expert testimony. PPL Electric will not be able to propose a procedural schedule until it is clear what issues will be raised in this proceeding, and the Company has had an opportunity to retain any expert witnesses necessary and to determine their availability for hearings.

V. SETTLEMENT

11. PPL Electric is willing to work with the Complainants in an attempt to resolve these proceedings through settlement.


VI. DISCOVERY

12. In order to determine the nature and scope of the case that the Complainants will present, on January 11, 2012, PPL Electric served upon the Complainants a set of discovery requests. Complainants did not respond to these discovery requests. PPL Electric did indicate that it would withdraw the discovery requests if the hearing was converted to a prehearing conference, as it has been. PPL Electric indicated further, however, that it may again serve the discovery requests, depending on the outcome of the prehearing conference.

13. To date, the Company has not received any discovery requests. PPL Electric is willing to engage in formal and informal discovery. PPL Electric does not propose any changes to the procedural rules governing discovery in this proceeding.


