

The five members of Kinetic Energy Associates, LLC ("Kinetic") are all attorneys in the law firm Hawke, McKeon & Sniscak, LLP ("HMS"), in Harrisburg, PA. HMS focuses its practice in the areas of public utility and energy law. HMS has been representing both public and investor owned utility companies, including electric, gas, water and sewer companies, for over thirty years. Several attorneys in HMS have been very closely involved in electric utility issues, including retail competition, since electric competition was introduced in Pennsylvania approximately fifteen years ago. The five members of Kinetic have combined experience of nearly one hundred (100) years in the utility and energy industry. Although the individual members of Kinetic gained their knowledge as attorneys, they will be working in the capacity of consultants when working for Kinetic.

 - Applicant shall report to the Commission the percentages of total electricity supplied by each fuel source on an annual basis:
 - Applicant will be required to meet periodic reporting requirements as may be issued by the Commission to fulfill the Commission's duty under Chapter 28 pertaining to reliability and to inform the Governor and Legislature of the progress of the transition to a fully competitive electric market.

C.S. §2810 (C)(6)(iv), Applicant, by filing of this application waives confidentiality with respect to its state tax information in the possession of the Department of Revenue, regardless of the source of the information, and shall consent to the Department of Revenue providing that information to the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission.
